What: Grant Writing Support and Consulting When: Monday, May 17, 2021 and June 3, 2021 by appointment – space is limited. Where: Video or Phone

This grant writing support program is designed to support community-based organizations that serve communities impacted by systemic oppression and do not have the internal capacity to hire a grant writer or have staff dedicated to grant writing.

We will be providing 45-60 minutes of free consultation and follow-up with a grant writer consultant to give you feedback and editing advice on your draft proposal. Our grant writing consultants can help by explaining the RFP, framing of the application, and/or editing a draft application.

Who is eligible for grant writing technical assistance?

This clinic is for organizations that are submitting a proposal for funding through the Human Services RFP that:

- Have budget of \$500,000 or less;
- Serve communities impacted by systemic oppression, which includes communities of color, immigrant and refugee communities, LGBTQ communities, persons with disabilities;
- The organization's service area must include the City of Bellevue

Preference will go to organizations whose leadership (Leadership Staff and Board of Directors) reflect the communities they serve.
