



NOTICE OF INSTALLATION:

Crosswalk flashing beacon

NE 24th Street and State Route 520 Trail crossing

To improve safety and visibility of pedestrians and bicyclists on the SR 520 trail crossing in Bridle Trails, the Bellevue Transportation Department plans to install an overhead rectangular rapid flashing beacon system at the mid-block crossing at NE 24th Street and the SR 520 Trail.



What to expect

- **Schedule:** Anticipated to begin in October 2021 with final installation in spring 2022. Schedule is subject to change.
- **Traffic control:** Limited periods of single-lane closures. Access to trail will remain open.
- **Safety:** Follow flaggers' instructions, obey traffic signs, and watch for people walking and biking.
- **Work Hours:** 7 a.m.-5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Funding

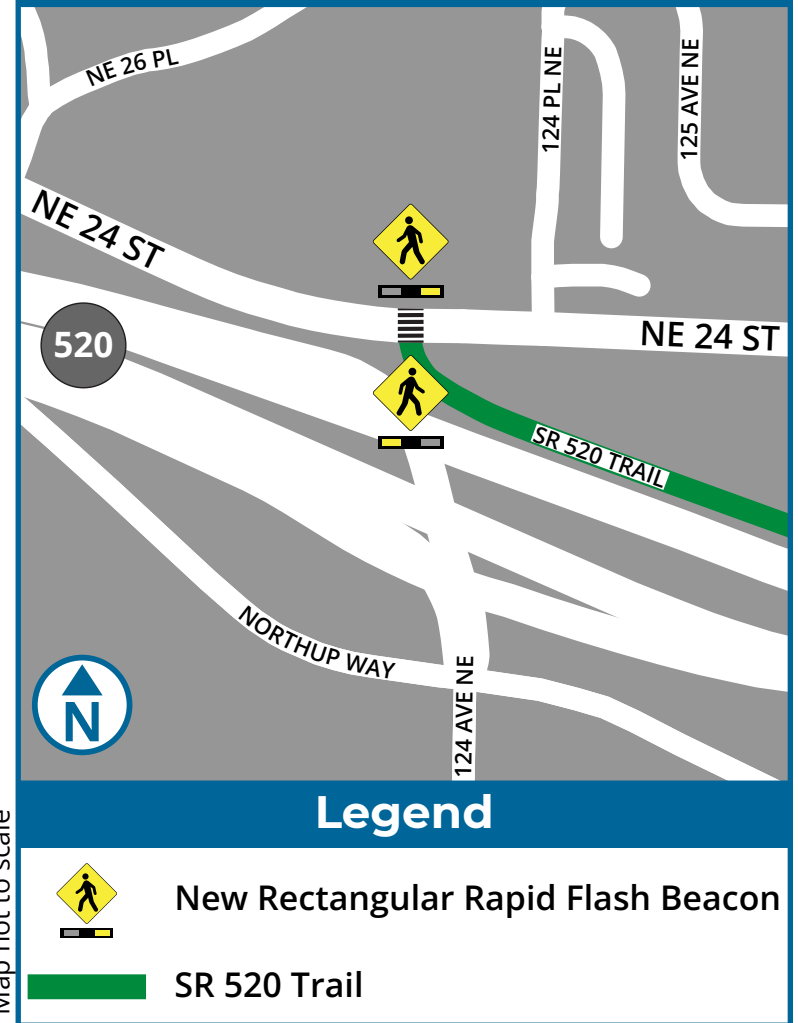

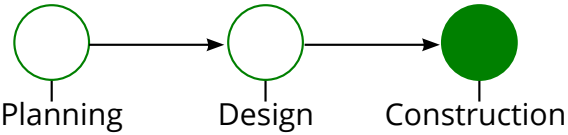
