



CONSTRUCTION ALERT: New Crosswalk 100th Avenue NE and NE 12th Street intersection

To improve safety and visibility of pedestrians in Downtown, the Bellevue Transportation Department plans to install a new crosswalk with a rectangular rapid flashing beacon system and new curb ramps at 100th Avenue NE and NE 12th Street.



What to expect

- **Schedule:** Anticipated to begin in October 2021 with final installation in spring 2022. Schedule is subject to change.
- **Traffic control:** Limited periods of single-lane closures and sidewalk detours.
- **Safety:** Follow flaggers' instructions, obey traffic signs, and watch for people walking and biking.
- **Work Hours:** 9 a.m.-5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Funding

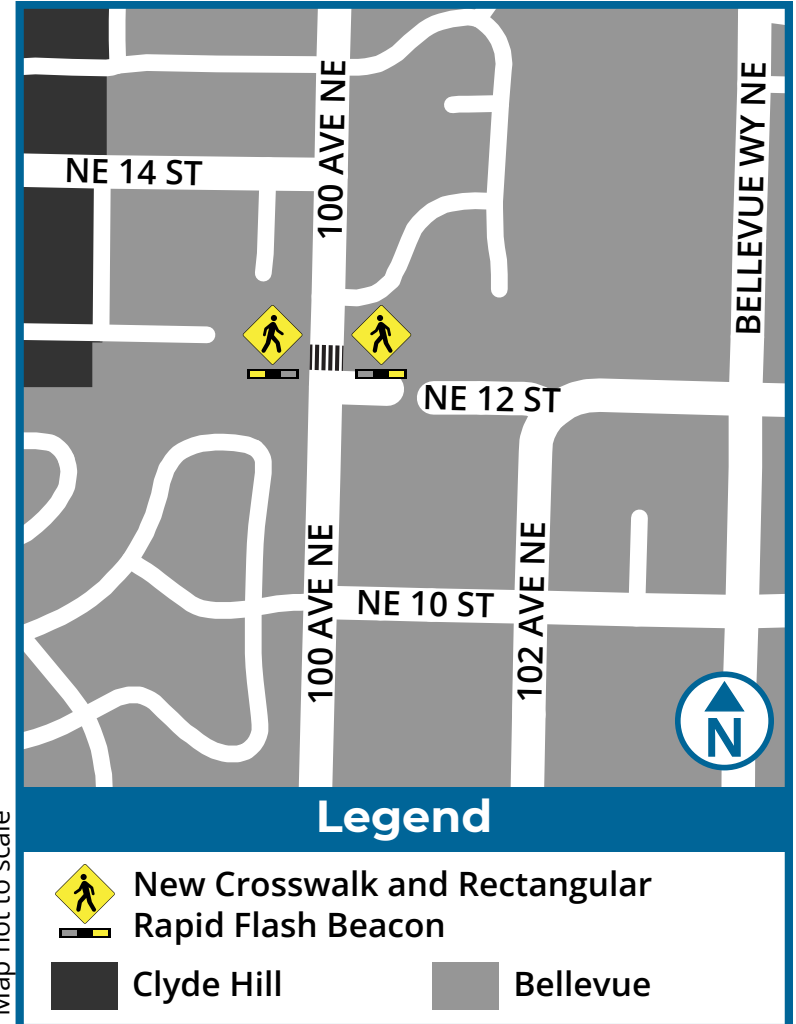
This project is one of three locations funded by the Neighborhood Enhancement Program and Traffic Operations Program. Estimated cost for all three crosswalk improvements is \$440,000.

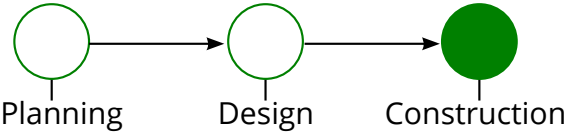
