Here in Bellevue, we want to ensure hate has no home. Thank you for helping us share this important message!

Below are instructions for recording yourself on your smartphone explaining what a safe, inclusive Bellevue feels like to you. Call or email ygarcia@bellevuewa.gov with any questions.

HATE HAS NO HOME HERE VIDEO SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:

Recordings *must be under 30 seconds* in length and include this information:

1. Introduce your name and your connection to Bellevue (Optional identifiers: last name, pronouns, race/ethnicity.) e.g. "I'm Thanh and I live in Northwest Bellevue."
2. In three words, what does an inclusive community feel like to you?
 - (e.g. "An inclusive community to me feels like _____, _____, and _____.")
3. End your video with the statement, "Hate has no home here!"
 - You can say this statement in any language or multiple languages

VIDEO TIPS:

- Using your phone may be the easiest method to record and send your video.
- Record your video with your mobile device turned horizontally (landscape layout.)
- Choose a well-lit environment.

RECORDING INSTRUCTIONS:

- Record your cell phone video on your smart phone (Android or iPhone).
- Record yourself, being sure to start recording and wait a second or two before smiling and speaking.
 - Send your video (or a link to access your video) to rsteel@bellevuewa.gov and ygarcia@bellevuewa.gov with the subject line 'Hate Has No Home Community Video' along with your name.
 - *iPhone users:* From your phone, go to camera/photos, select your video and click the Share icon. From the drop-down menu, select "Copy iCloud Link". Paste the link in an email and send to rsteel@bellevuewa.gov and ygarcia@bellevuewa.gov.
 - *Android users:* From your phone, select Google Photos. Then select the video and hit "share". Select "Create Link" Copy the link. Paste the link in an email and send it to rsteel@bellevuewa.gov and ygarcia@bellevuewa.gov.

By submitting a video, you agree that you are participating in this project and give permission for the video and/or photo screenshots from the video to be reproduced by the City of Bellevue. You also give permission for the video and/or photograph(s) to appear on City of Bellevue websites, television stations and/or print publications.
