



# **Road Closure and Detour**



As part of the Mountains to Sound Greenway Trail construction project, it will be necessary to close a portion of SE 36th Street between 132nd Avenue SE and 142nd Place SE to build traffic islands, complete utilities work and restore the roadway (see map). This new section of the Trail is expected to be open by the end of 2021. There will be four continuous closures (24 hours a day); the dates and times are noted below. Construction schedules are subject to change and often do.

### Access

- Vehicles will be detoured along SE Eastgate Way, between Factoria Boulevard SE/Richards Road and 150th Avenue SE. See map.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained along the sidewalk on the south side of SE 36th Street.

 Bicycle access is available via the vehicle detour or on the sidewalk on the south side of SE 36th Street.

- Follow police and flagger instructions.
- Drive slowly near the construction zone.
- Plan your travel in advance.
