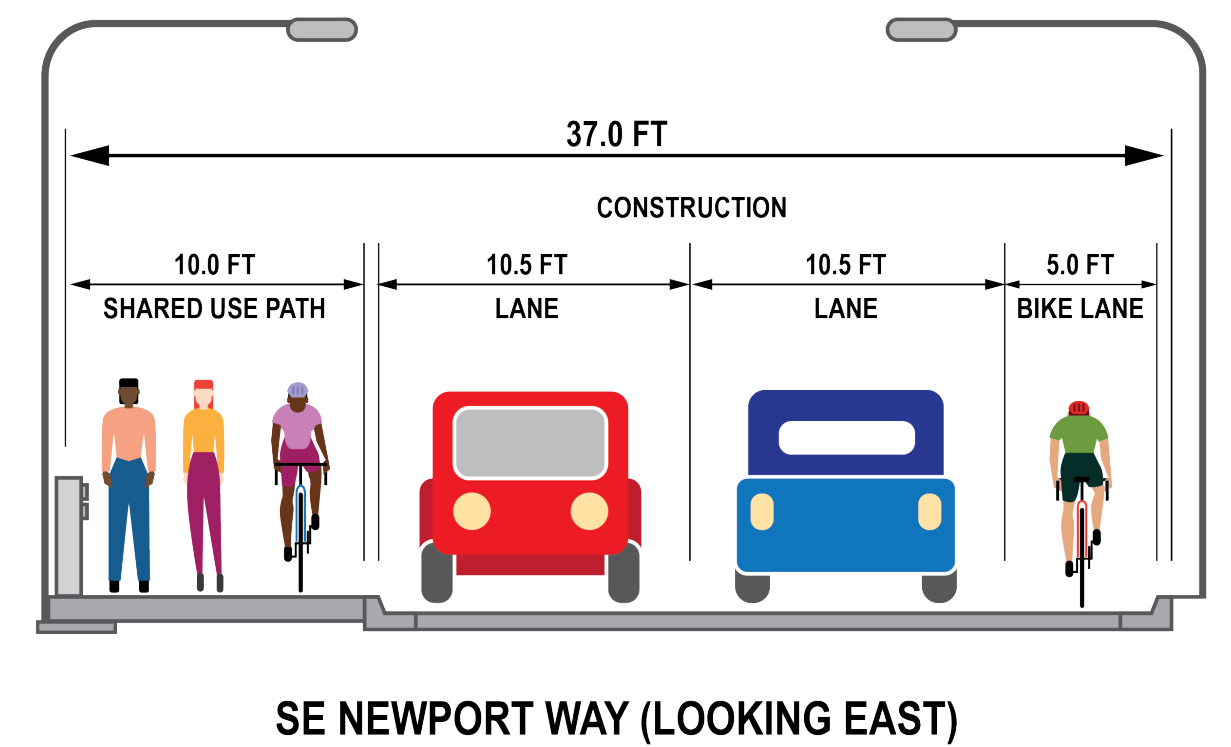

SE Newport Way at 149th Place SE

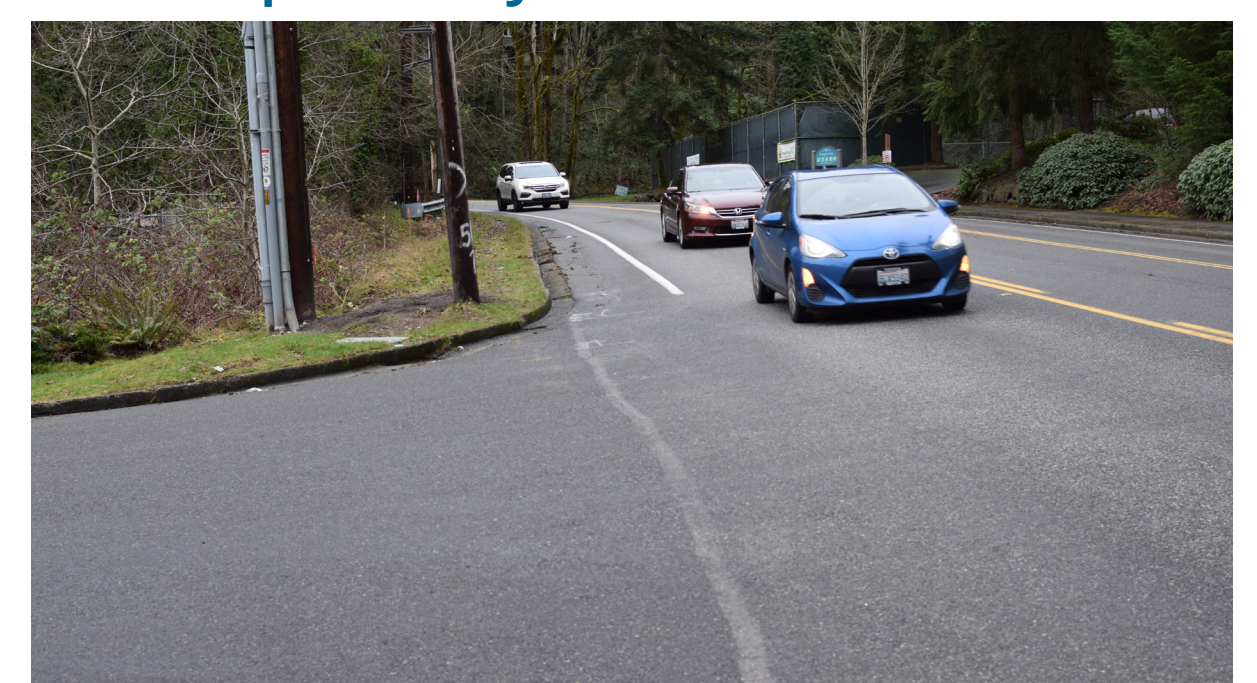

This project connects pedestrians and bicyclists with the South Bellevue Community Center, the Newport Way Library, churches, parks, schools, and other nearby destinations, making SE Newport Way safer and more accessible for all users.

Quick facts

- **Where:** SE Newport Way between Somerset Boulevard SE and 150th Avenue SE
- **Total project length:** 0.85 miles
- **Timeline:** Design finalized in 2018, construction began in April 2020, substantial completion in November 2020, official competition in July 2021
- The **Newport Way Sidewalk Committee** played an important role in requesting and advocating for these improvements
- **Cost:** \$11 million

Improvements

- 10-foot-wide multipurpose path
- 5-foot-wide bike lane
- Upgraded 10.5-foot-wide vehicle travel lane in both directions
- 6-foot-wide sidewalk between 150th Avenue SE and the South Bellevue Community Center
- Mid-block crosswalk with rectangular rapid flashing beacons (RRFB)
- Nine new retaining walls, plus new sections of guardrail, lighting and signage
