


#### Land Acknowledgement







#### System thinking


1884, Oregon officially banned blacks from moving to the state in its state constitution.




Sun-Down Laws



One such practice was to require African-Americans to leave town before sunset. If they were found on the streets after sunset, they would be picked up by the police and dropped on the roadside outside of town or worse. Hence the name "sundown towns."



This sign at the entrance of Innis Arden advertised to all entering the Shoreline subdivision that it was a "restricted community."

#### Examples of Bellevue Restrictive Covenants

Bellevue	Enatai	Enatai Waterfront Addition	No person of African, Japanese, Chinese, or of any other Mongolian descent shall be allowed to purchase, own or lease said real property or any part thereof.
Bellevue	Killarney Park	<u>Killarney No.</u>	No person of any race other than the White race shall use or occupy any building or lot, except that this covenant shall not prevent occupancy by domestic servants of a different race domiciled with an owner or tenant.
Bellevue	Moorland	Shorelands	That neither said premises, nor any interest therein shall at any time be leased, sold, devised or conveyed to, or inherited by or otherwise acquired by, become the property of, used or occupied by any person other than one of the White or Caucasian race, provided however, that persons not of the White or Caucasian race may be kept thereon by such a Caucasian occupant strictly in the capacity of servants of such occupants.


#### Opportunity Mapping
