

# Tree Health Check Program 2022 Information Guide

## Program Purpose

Did you receive a tree from our 2021 Trees for Bellevue Tree Giveaway Program? If so, you are eligible for our Tree Health Check Program! This program provides an online tree health assessment service during the summer of 2022. The goals of the program are:

- For Bellevue residents to ask questions about tree care.
- To understand and increase the survivability of given away trees.

## Program Overview

After submitting the program form with a description and photos of your tree(s), you will receive a simple health assessment, answers to any submitted questions, and recommended steps to maintain the health of your tree(s).

It is important to note the Tree Health Checks will not be performed by a certified arborist and further tree care services, outside of this program, may be recommended.

We have limited staff and volunteer capacity and therefore may not be able to provide health checks to all that submit.

## Qualifications

In order to receive this service, you must have received at least one tree from the 2021 Trees for Bellevue Tree Giveaway Program and have planted that tree at your residence within the City of Bellevue.
