



**PUBLIC NOTICE  
CITY OF BELLEVUE  
PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD**

In accordance with 24 CFR 91.05(c)(2) and subpart B of the federal regulations relative to citizen participation for Community Planning and Development Programs and applicable waivers made available to those requirements through the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act), the City of Bellevue is making the second amendment to the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) 2019 Annual Action Plan available for public comment through this notice.

**2019 Annual Action Plan Second Amendment:**

This is the second amendment to the 2019 Annual Action Plan to allow the City of Bellevue to receive and administer \$897,623 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development made available through the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act). This funding, known as CDBG-CV3, is to be used for eligible activities to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus.

The City of Bellevue is proposing to allocate its CDBG-CV3 funds as follows:
