>**BOARD 1** – Modified Master Plan

(Page 1)

- Expense of NEW Aquatic Center? Existing one? (What happens to the old aquatic center?)
- No basketball or soccer?
- Dual use for tennis courts
- Priority of amphitheater? Tanked lowly. (+1)
- Likes Alt #1 concept (Pool/Aquatic placement)
- Smaller building footprint on Alt #2. * Include field
- Field should be dedicated to pickleball facility. Courts only take 1/3 acre.
- Put Aquatic Center in a more business area – It is not compatible with “OPEN” PARK LAND

(Page 2)

- More ALL GRASS natural area
- Add additional (4) pickleball courts
- Would like to be made aware of cost of aquatic center
- Option for elevated pickleball courts?
- How will Methane be addressed?
- Consideration to include airport history in design (ie: playground structures?)
- Tree density? Lighting
- Consider more bathrooms
- Court maintenance. Algae, tree debris
- *** Pay switch to control lights.

>**BOARD 2** – Alternative #1

(Page 1 of 1):

- Minimum 18 pickleball courts
- Night lit pickleball
- Covered pickleball – 2 min.
- Pickleball on roof if won't fit elsewhere
- Concerned w/ cos of building on top of landfill – methane reroute
- Non-skid surface in pool, locker rooms, steps
- Can aquatic center include a 2nd floor for indoor pickleball/sports events?
- No tennis – they are at Robinswood already (checkmark)

- Canopy – for pickleball (See pic)
- Half covered/* Half open (Cantilever overhang)

>**BOARD 3** – Alternative #2

(Page 1):

- No more tennis in Bellevue (Check-check-check-check-checkmark)
- More pickleball – Ideal
 - * 16 courts in 1 location
 - * Builds community
 - * Potential events
- Consider a parking garage → More park (Agreed!)
- Possible to move pickleball to the south
- Access to outside restrooms and drinking fountains
- Covered pickleball and Lights
 - * Light Pollution issue?
 - * Safety in lighting!
- Pickleball viewed from parking or street
- Pickleball on roof?
- Put aquatic center in “commercial” type are

(Page 2)

- Alt. 2 allows better views of park/trees from the parking/entry
- Parking closer to pickleball courts (checkmark)
- 16 pickleball courts *Day 1* (checkmark)
- Pickleball facility designed as a “destination” equipped for tournaments (checkmark)
- Place for food trucks to serve the events
- LIGHTS (Solar) on the pickleball courts
- Pickleball – half covered/half open
