- Volunteer six hours a month, including general network member on the last Tuesday of every month and monthly subcommittee meetings; must be able to serve a two-year term; and
- Attend the BDAN Annual Retreat on Saturday, Oct. 22, 2022, 9 a.m.-1 p.m.
