Lake Hills Boulevard and 148th Avenue SE Intersection Improvements

September 2022

To address neighborhood traffic congestion, delays and queuing at the intersection of Lake Hill Blvd. and 148th Ave. SE, the Bellevue Transportation Department plans to:



Add a second left turn lane from westbound Lake Hills Blvd. to southbound 148th Ave SE.



Replace sidewalk



Relocate eastbound bike lane to new curb line



Modify traffic islands



Upgrade accessibility ramp



Modify traffic signal



Restore roadway

What to expect

Construction is expected to begin in September 2022. Some work is weather dependent.

Construction schedules are subject to change.

- **Approved work hours:**
8 a.m.-3 p.m., Monday-Friday
- **Traffic control:** Expect daytime lane closures. Follow traffic control flaggers' instructions.
- **Pedestrian/bicycle access:** Pedestrian and bicycle access will be maintained during construction.

Funding

Construction funding comes from the Neighborhood Safety, Connectivity and Congestion Levy. Estimated cost is \$950,000.

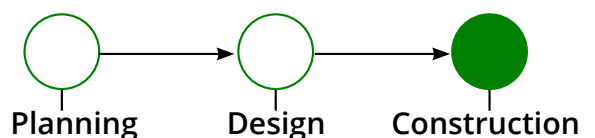
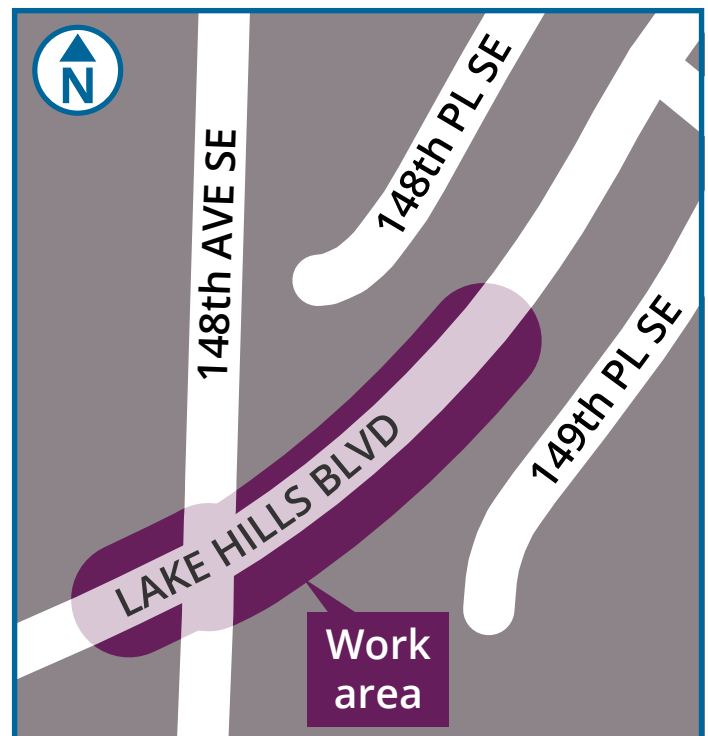
