Roles & Responsibilities

- The Transportation Commission was directed by the City Council to serve in an advisory role to the Transportation Director who, after considering the Commission's recommendation, has the authority to direct staff to implement Bike Bellevue.
- In its advisory role, the Transportation Commission will consider technical analysis conducted by staff and community input to identify bicycle infrastructure investment priorities that will fill gaps along corridors in the project area consistent with the Council approved project principles.
- The decision to repurpose travel lanes on existing streets to achieve bicycle performance targets in the Mobility Implementation Plan rests with the Transportation Director.

Engagement Outcomes

- Raising Project Awareness (April-July 2023): Build awareness, foster relationships, promote upcoming engagement opportunities.
- Design Engagement (July-September 2023): Encourage engagement with online project design feedback tool and invite input from focus groups and stakeholder interviews.
- Design Refinement (September-November 2023): Refine corridor designs based on community and Transportation Commission feedback.

Engagement Outcomes


- Corridor Prioritization (September 2023 January 2024): Refine preliminary corridor designs and prioritization based on community and Transportation Commission feedback.
- Open House (December 2023): In-Person Open House at City Hall seeking community input on project designs and prioritization.
- Bike Bellevue Recommendation (January-February 2024): Refine recommendation based on Transportation Commission feedback.




Bike Bellevue Timeline
