AN EASIER WAY TO APPROACH YOUR LICENSE

The City of Bellevue understands that dealing with overdue traffic fines and holds on your driver's license can be a daunting experience.

For that reason, the License Support Program ("LSP"), operated by Bellevue Probation Services, will walk with you through the process.

How much does it cost?

There is no fee associated with the service.

How does it work?

Once an individual has expressed interest in the program, an interview will be scheduled with one of our volunteers at Bellevue Probation. The interview involves analyzing the individual requirements for reinstatement of the driver's license. These conditions may involve the following:

- Unpaid fines
- Out-of-state driving issues
- Unpaid insurance claims from previous collisions
- Child support holds

Upon completion of the interview, a plan of action will be developed. The License Support Program will assist you every step along the way.
