# Project Update

## 120TH AVENUE NE MULTIMODAL CORRIDOR COMPLETION PROJECT between the future NE 16th Street and Northup Way in BelRed

The Bellevue Transportation Department is working to improve 120th Avenue NE between the future NE 16th Street and Northup Way by enhancing mobility and safety for people walking, biking, driving and taking transit.

Design work has advanced to 90% completion. The city proposes to construct the project in two phases with north and south segments. The north segment would be built first from the King County Metro transit base (East Base) to Northup Way, followed by the south segment from the future NE 16th Street to East Base.

Based on community feedback collected through an online open house in 2021, the traffic analysis report was re-evaluated. The city recommends three to four total lanes instead of the originally proposed five-lane roadway. The proposed roadway section includes one northbound through lane within the project limits and two southbound through lanes to be extended from the future NE 16th Street to East Base. The rest of the southbound through lane would remain at one lane within the project limits. Additionally, a center lane would be added that could be utilized as a left-turn lane, a second left-turn lane or a median island.

Funding for construction has not been secured.

### Project timeline

- 2022-2023** Complete 100% of design work
- 2025-2026** Right-of-way acquisitions and permits
- TBD** North segment construction, timing based on funding availability

### Proposed improvements



Widen 120th Avenue NE to three to four lanes



Add new pedestrian and bicycle facilities on both sides of the roadway



Replace the culvert under the roadway to improve fish passage



Upgrade utility and stormwater facilities



Improve landscaping and lighting



Improve traffic signals



Enhance corridor signage



Update pavement and striping

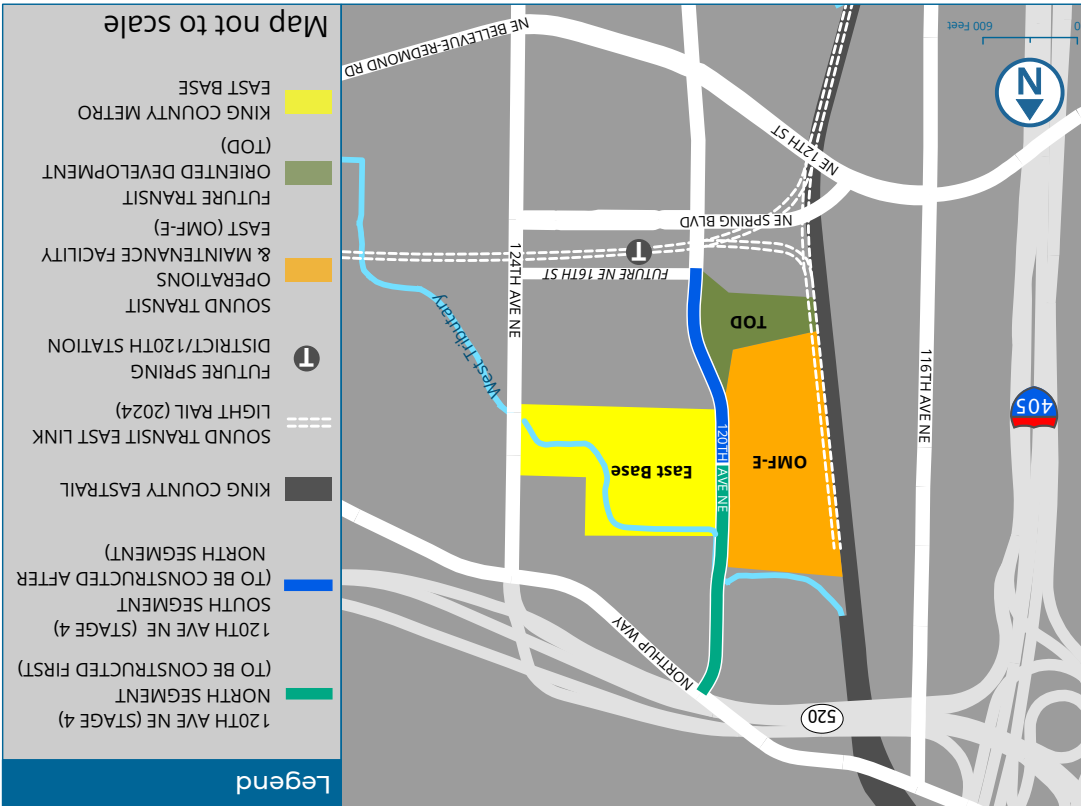
