Main Street crosswalk improvements

The City of Bellevue Transportation Department will be improving safety for people walking and rolling by installing three new flashing beacons at the following crosswalk locations along Main Street:

- Trail at 14300 Block
- 145th Place Northeast
- 153rd Place Northeast

What to expect

- **Construction:** Starting February 2024
- **Work Hours:** 8:30 a.m.-3:30 p.m.
- **Traffic impact:** Intermittent lane closures with flaggers present. Access for people walking and rolling will be maintained.

Please note that construction schedules are subject to change and often do.

- 153th Place Northeast

Qué esperar

- **Construcción:** Inicia en febrero de 2024
- **Horas de trabajo:** De 8:30 a. m. a 3:30 p. m.
- **Consecuencias en el tráfico:** Habrá cierres intermitentes de carriles y el tráfico será dirigido por banderilleros. Se mantendrá el acceso para las personas que circulen caminando o patinando.

Tenga en cuenta que los horarios de trabajo están sujetos a cambios y pueden modificarse.

- Переход на 153 Place Northeast

Что ожидать

- **Строительство:** С февраля 2024 г.
- **Часы проведения работ:** 8:30-15:30
- **Влияние на дорожное движение:** Полосы будут периодически перекрываться, движение будет регулироваться регулировщиками движения. Доступ для пешеходов и передвигающихся на роликах будет сохранен.

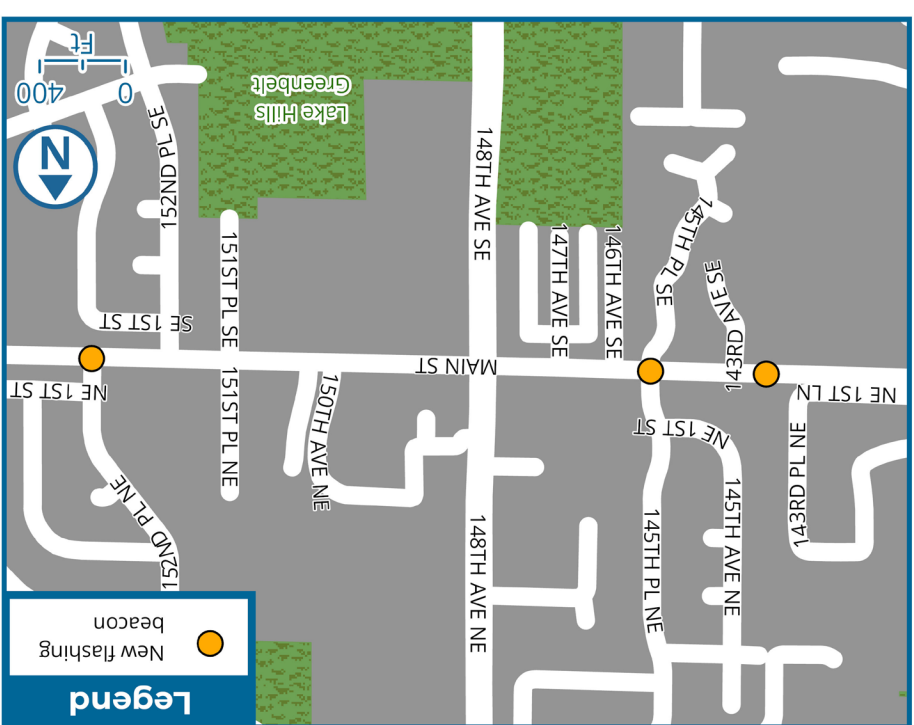
