- 2. Comprehensive Plan Implementation Overview– Thara Johnson and Nick Whipple
- Implementation of the Comprehensive Plan
 - Major updates have been made to land use designations.
 - Opportunity to streamline the Comprehensive Plan's implementation through the two-year Land Use Planning Initiatives (LUPI) workplan.
 - The Plan includes broader land use designations and classifications, allowing more land use districts to "nest" within a designation.
 - Illustrations were added to the Comprehensive Plan to help the community understand concepts like scale and density.
- A question was raised about how development projects will be reviewed against the new Comprehensive Plan. It was clarified that the Comprehensive Plan is a policy document, not a regulatory one. Regulations are being updated to align with city policy in the Comprehensive Plan. Until the updated regulations take effect, projects must comply with current land use regulations. Proposals under review will be evaluated against the code currently in effect, not the code changes that are in process.
- A question was raised about what to do if a project is already in process under the current code, but the applicant wants to be considered under the new code. The response was that applicants should consult their project planner to determine which code applies to their project and whether they can take advantage of newly adopted regulations.
