**Under the Opioids settlement agreement, the City of Bellevue is hiring a Opioid Use Disorder Crisis Response and Outreach Worker to be added to the Bellevue Fire CARES team. This social worker would support community members struggling with an opioid use disorder or experiencing an opioid crisis to connect to treatment resources. The social worker would address barriers to successful treatment through navigation support and/or direct provision of resources that would enable access to treatment for individuals with financial need, such as transportation, temporary shelter while awaiting a treatment bed, etc. Dependent on workload, this individual would also provide education on prevention and intervention related to opioids to external and internal stakeholders.**
