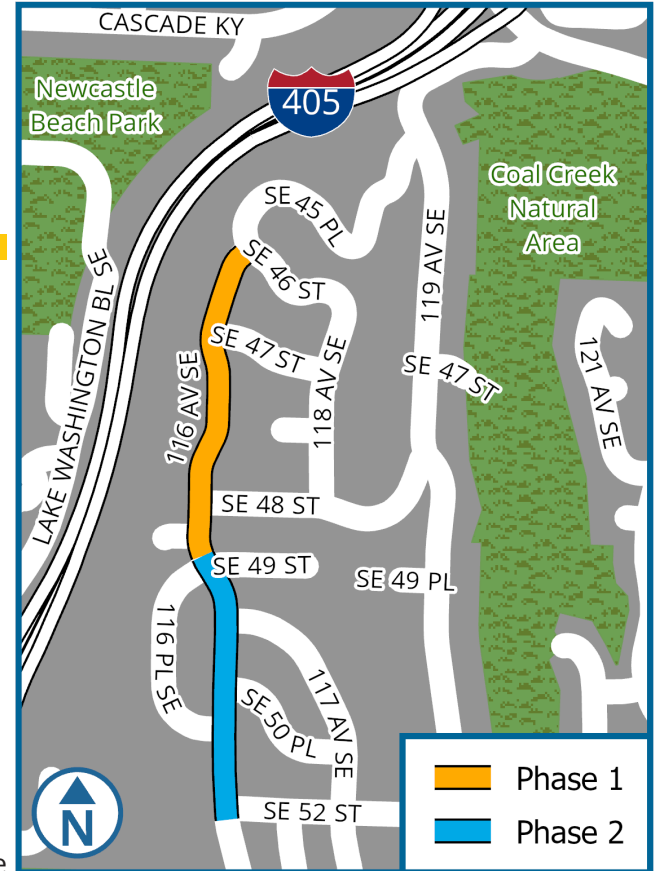
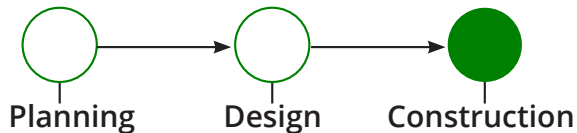
## 116th Avenue SE road striping

### Description

The City of Bellevue Transportation Department will be adding road striping (paint that shows where the lanes are) to 116th Avenue SE between SE 46th Street and SE 52nd Street. Phase 1 of this work will happen at the same time as repaving, which is part of the city-wide Pavement Preservation Program. Phase 2 of this work will occur in early fall as part of a city-wide channelization project. New shared shoulders will be added to both sides of the road for most of this section. In some areas where the road is narrower, there will only be a shoulder on one side. These new shoulders will visually narrow the roadway and have a traffic calming effect.
