A new six-foot wide sidewalk along the north side of NE 40th St from 140th Ave NE to 145th Ave NE



New crosswalks at 142nd Pl NE



New five-foot wide bike lanes along NE 40th St from 140th Ave NE to 146th Ave NE




Grind and overlay (repave)

Storm drainage improvements



Four-foot planters, where feasible, including landscaping and irrigation



Project schedule

The design for this project is anticipated to be completed in September 2024 with construction starting in late fall 2024.

Funding

This project has an estimated construction cost of \$4 million, with funding from the Neighborhood Safety, Connectivity and Congestion Levy, the Neighborhood Sidewalk Program, the Pavement Preservation Program, the Traffic Operations Program, the Neighborhood Enhancement Program and the Utilities Department.
