Use Less Toxic Options

READ THE LABEL BEFORE YOU BUY.

Use the least hazardous product that does the job. Avoid products labeled **DANGER**, **POISON**, **CAUTION**, or **WARNING**.





SAFEST

Find products with these logos on the front or back.

EPA Safer Choice products are the safest choice.





SAFE ENOUGH

Select products that do NOT have the words caution, warning, danger or poison in the label.





SOMEWHAT HARMFUL

Select products that have the words caution or warning.





AVOID

Avoid products with the words danger or poison. They are most harmful for you and your family.

NEVER MIX HOUSEHOLD CLEANERS.

Do not mix bleach with other cleaners, especially ammonia products. These mixtures create hazardous gases.



S Rent a container you can fill for disposal.

Not accepted from dump trucks, dump trailers, flat beds that dump, or roll off boxes. Items restricted to 8 ft long and up to 200 lbs.

Electronics





If 2ft. x 2ft. x 2ft. or smaller and fewer than 60 lbs, then place next to your recycling cart. Find more locations to recycle broken or obsolete electronics at ecyclewa.org.

Fluorescent Tubes and Bulbs, CFL and HID lights





Prohibited from disposing in the garbage

Recycle fluorescent lights, CFLs, and HIDs at no charge. Find participating locations at lightrecycle.org

Tubes: Wrap in paper and secure with tape. No longer than 4 ft.

Bulbs: Seal in plastic bag. Limit two tubes/bulbs each pickup/drop off

Medicines

Rigid Plastics











Propane Tanks and Cylinders

Scrap Metal





Large items. Smaller pieces okay in your cart. No greasy auto parts.

Shredded Paper



Shred only what you need. Shredded paper has fewer recycling uses than whole sheets of paper.

Bring confidential paper documents to a community shred event.
