#### How to use this bulletin

#### To learn more about a project:

- Click the hyperlinked project name to view digital documentation. Not all notices have hyperlinks.
- Submit a request online to review the project file at <u>Bellevuewa.gov/city-government/departments/city-clerks-office/public-records/development-services-records</u>
- Call the planner assigned to the project to arrange to review the project files. The planner's contact information is in the notice.

#### To comment on a project:

- Send your comments in writing to the Development Services Department. Be sure to include your name and address.
- Comments will be accepted until the time a staff report is prepared for the decision or recommendation, with a minimum comment period of at least 14 days, 21 days for non-emergency rulemaking, and 30 days for shoreline.
- If you submit a written comment, we will send you a copy of the notice of decision or recommendation.

#### To appeal a permit decision or SEPA determination:

- You must have filed a written comment expressing your concerns before the decision was made.
- Any appeal of a DSD decision to the Hearing Examiner must be received by the City Clerk's Office no later than 5 p.m. on the appeal deadline indicated on the notice. The appeal must include a written statement in the form described in LUC 20.35.250.A.2 together with an appeal notification form.

• An appeal of a shoreline decision is made to the State Shoreline Hearing Board, must be in writing, and must be filed within 21 days of the date the DSD decision is received by the State Department of Ecology (DOE). The DSD decision will be sent to DOE by the close of business on the date of this notice. ## General Information Regarding Use of Optional DNS Process

When the SEPA field indicates a Determination of Non-significance (DNS) is expected, the optional DNS process is being used, and a DNS is likely. This may be the only opportunity to comment on the environmental impacts of the proposal. The proposal may include mitigation measures under applicable codes, and the project review process may incorporate or require mitigation measures regardless of whether an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is prepared. **Description:** Application for Master Development Plan (MDP) approval to construct a three-phased development that includes two residential towers and one residential mid-rise building with approximately 1,397 units and a 1,464,200 gross square foot office tower. The Master Development Plan total site area is 123,800 square feet (6.63 acre) and is located within the Urban Core (UC) zoning. The proposal includes construction of the Grand Connection through the center of the MDP and the Eastrail Corridor along the eastern frontage of the site. In addition, the application for the Phase 1 Design Review has been submitted which includes 2 residential buildings with approximately 625 units, 790 parking stalls, totaling 991,515 gross square feet. Improvements for Phase 1 include development of a segment of the Eastrail Corridor frontage and Grand Connection.

**Approvals Required:** Master Plan Development approval, Design Review approval, and ancillary permits and approvals
