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## How to use this bulletin

### To learn more about a project:

- Submit a request online to review the project file at [Bellevuewa.gov/city-government/departments/city-clerks-office/public-records/development-services-records](https://Bellevuewa.gov/city-government/departments/city-clerks-office/public-records/development-services-records)
- Call the planner assigned to the project to arrange to review the project files. The planner's contact information is in the notice.

### To comment on a project:

- Send your comments in writing to the Development Services Department. Be sure to include your name and address.
- Comments will be accepted until the time a staff report is prepared for the decision or recommendation, with a minimum comment period of at least 14 days (30 days for shoreline projects).
- If you submit a written comment, we will send you a copy of the notice of decision or recommendation.

### To appeal a permit decision or SEPA determination:

- You must have filed a written comment expressing your concerns before the decision was made.
- Any appeal of a DSD decision to the Hearing Examiner must be received by the City Clerk's Office no later than 5 p.m. on the appeal deadline indicated on the notice. The appeal must include a written statement in the form described in LUC 20.35.250.A.2 together with an [appeal notification form](#).

- An appeal of a shoreline decision is made to the State Shoreline Hearing Board, must be in writing, and must be filed within 21 days of the date the DSD decision is received by the State Department of Ecology (DOE). The DSD decision will be sent to DOE by the close of business on the date of this notice. ## General Information Regarding Use of Optional DNS Process

When the SEPA field indicates a Determination of Non-significance (DNS) is expected, the optional DNS process is being used, and a DNS is likely. This may be the only opportunity to comment on the environmental impacts of the proposal. The proposal may include mitigation measures under applicable codes, and the project review process may incorporate or require mitigation measures regardless of whether an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is prepared. The Threshold Determination will also be noticed in a subsequent issue of this Weekly Permit Bulletin. A copy of the subsequent Threshold Determination for the proposal may be obtained upon request.

**Description:** Land Use review of a Conditional Use Permit, Critical Areas Land Use Permit, and Noise Variance application to repair approximately 5,600 feet of the existing Eastside Interceptor 8 concrete wastewater tunnel and replacement of the Sweyolocken force mains. Repair activities require placement of a bypass pump system and at-grade piping. The project includes installation of a 36" HDPE pipe between the King County Eastrail Trail property and the Coal Creek Natural Area to facilitate bypass and allow for future maintenance of the ESI system. The applicant has requested a noise variance to allow for the bypass pump system to operate for approximately 12 months during the estimate repair window.

**Approvals Required:** Conditional Use Permit approval, Critical Areas Land Use Permit approval, Noise Variance approval and ancillary permits and approvals.

**SEPA:** Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) was issued by King County, as lead agency, on April 1, 2025. See attached SEPA DNS for more information.

**Minimum Comment Period:** Beginning on May 29, 2025, lasting fourteen (14) days, and ending on June 12, 2025, 5 PM. Comments continue to be accepted until the City issues a decision or
