Cost: \$165,000

Location: Various locations in the Bridle Trails neighborhood area



Description: This project would construct up to five new Bridle Trails neighborhood identity signs to replace existing deteriorated signage throughout the neighborhood. Residents would have the opportunity to provide input into sign design selection during a resident review of the proposed signs. Signs will be designed and constructed as per City of Bellevue sign code guidelines.






BT-2: Radar Feedback Signs on 132nd Ave NE between the S-Curve and NE 60th St

Cost: \$150,000

Location: 132nd Ave NE between the S-Curve and NE 60th St



Description: This project would install two speed radar feedback signs, one in each direction, on 132nd Ave NE between the S-Curve and NE 60th St.

BT-3: Radar Feedback Signs on NE 40th St between 140th Ave NE and 148th Ave NE

Cost: \$150,000

Location: NE 40th St between 140th Ave NE and 148th Ave NE



Description: This project would install two speed radar feedback signs, one in each direction, on NE 40th St between 140th Ave NE and 148th Ave NE.

BT-4: Viewpoint Park Forest Enhancement

Cost: \$165,000

Location: Viewpoint Park



Description:

This project would enhance forest health within Viewpoint Park by removing non-native species, such as English ivy and Himalayan blackberry, and introducing native trees and shrubs. The newly planted vegetation would be maintained until it becomes established and self-sustaining. These efforts would foster a more diverse and resilient forest ecosystem, improving wildlife habitat and strengthening essential ecological functions.

BT-5: Adult Play Equipment at Goldsmith Park

Cost: \$45,000

Location: Goldsmith Park



Description:

This project would include an adult exercise equipment station adjacent to the existing playground at Goldsmith Park. The equipment would allow park users to exercise while watching their children. Equipment may consist of cardio, torso stability, and leg extension equipment.






BT-6: Goff Creek clean up

Cost: \$47,500

Location: Goff Creek at NE 24th St between 130th Pl NE and 131st Pl NE



Description: This project would remove ivy, stabilize slopes, add native plant species to reduce stormwater runoff and erosion, and perform maintenance to ensure plant survival. The project area is approximately 8,000 square feet and 200 linear feet of streambank. City would provide outreach with 4 identified properties upstream of the project location.

BT-7: Pike's Peak Neighborhood Street Lights

Cost: \$36,000

Location: NE 26th PI / 122nd PI NE between NE 24th St and NE 37th St;

120th Ave NE



Description: This project would install up to fourteen (14) new PSE owned and maintained LED street lights on existing PSE utility poles along NE 26th Pl/122nd Pl NE and on 120th Ave NE. Each proposed streetlight would be subject to a 100% homeowner approval within a 100 foot radius of the proposed street light, prior to installation, if this project is voted in. Proposed street light locations are estimated locations.






BT-8: Painted Shoulder Lines on both sides of 130th Ave NE between NE 24th St and NE 32nd Pl

Cost: \$15,000

Location: 130th Ave NE between NE 24th St and NE 32nd Pl



Description: This project would install shoulder lines on both sides of 130th Ave NE between NE 24th St and NE 32nd Pl. The shoulder lines are intended to have a lane narrowing effect and reduce vehicle speeds.

Description: This project would assist in maintenance of the approximately sixty (60) existing post-top street lights in the Cherry Crest Neighborhood. The posts would be cleaned, repainted, and the globe system, including the lens, would be replaced with new tops.




BT-11: Bridle Trails Medians Landscape Enhancement

Cost: \$ 58,500

Location: Planter islands on 140th Ave NE, NE 40th St, 148th Ave NE at NE 40th,

and 130th Ave NE



Description: This project would include landscape renovation and site improvements in several of the medians in the Bridle Trails area. Work would include removal of declining shrubs, installation of drought tolerant plants and bulbs where appropriate, soil grading and amendment, and top dressed

with bark mulch. Medians considered for enhancement would need to be accessible for hand watering, due to the lack of irrigation present.






BT-13: 140th Ave NE Landscape Refurbishment

Cost: \$79,000

Location: 140th Ave NE, between NE 24th St and NE 60th St



Description: This project would include landscape renovation and site improvements along 140th Ave NE, in selected planter beds on the East and West sides of the road. Work would include removal of declining shrubs, installation of drought tolerant plants, bulbs and turf grass where appropriate, soil grading, and compost amendments. Areas considered for renovation will need to be accessible for hand watering, due to the lack of irrigation present.

Cost: \$7,000

Location: Bridle Trails Corner Park
