The collection enhances the experience of Bellevue's public places, fosters community pride and belonging, raises the discourse on the defining aspects of Bellevue's civic life, and explores the diverse identities and converging cultures of our residents, creative sectors, and the interplay between nature and the urban experience.

Eligibility

The Eastside Artist Roster is open to all artists living or working in Bellevue, Bothell, Duvall, Issaquah, Kirkland, Mercer Island, Newcastle, North Bend, Redmond, Renton, Sammamish, Snoqualmie and Woodinville. Artists living or working in other areas may still apply for other opportunities as they are advertised. It is up to the artist to determine their eligibility for the Eastside Artist Roster.

Application Deadlines

There is no deadline. Artists can elect to be removed from the roster at any time.

- **Application details** Fill out all required fields in the online application form, including name, contact information, what type of artist you are and what opportunities you may be interested in.
- **Artist Bio (150 words)** Please summarize your background as well as artistic influences, training, and major achievements.
