The mission of Seattle Area Cup Tennis is to provide an opportunity for women in the greater Seattle area to play competitive tennis in a social environment.

The Seattle Area Cup Tennis (SACT) League has been the premier women's daytime tennis league for the Greater Seattle Area since 2005. Each year SACT hosts over 200 teams from 30 different tennis facilities around the area. We welcome all levels of play and provide opportunities for doubles and singles match play. A typical season runs from September to February.

SACT is organized into levels, dependent on ability. There are 6 levels ranging from players with USTA ratings of 5.0 and above to those with ratings of 2.5. It is not necessary to have a USTA rating to participate, however players must be over the age of 21 and not currently playing at the collegiate level.
