1. Senate Bill (SB) 5290 Background

- SB 5290 Project Overview
 - o Amended the Local Project Review Act (RCW 36.70B)
 - Focused on Land Use and environmental permits
 - o Goal to create efficiencies and streamline permitting
 - Mandatory permit review timelines
 - o Included penalties and streamlining incentives for jurisdictions
 - Effective summer 2023 and beyond
- Department of Commerce Role
 - Lead role for implementation across the state
 - Administer two grant programs
 - Convene statewide digital permitting work group
 - Provide technical assistance and guidance to jurisdictions
 - o Template and guidance for annual performance report
 - Plan to provide local governments with temporary permit staff

- SB 5290 Key Components
 - o Procedural and administrative
 - Prohibits site plan review on interior alterations

- Requires clear submittal requirements
- Requirements for completeness check process
- Publish performance report at local and state level
- Changes to terminology and definitions
- o Permit timelines "Shot Clocks"
- 65 days when a public notice is not required
- 100 days when a public notice is required
- o 170 days when public notice and public hearing is required
- Permit fee refund penalties
- Streamlining measures
- o Incentivized the adoption of three measures to avoid permit fee refunds

■ SB 5290 Overview

- Land Use Code changes adopted and effective Jan. 1
- Codified permit timelines for project permits
- o Procedural changes and updates
- Director rulemaking
- Streamlining measures adopted and effective January 1
- Three resourcing measures implemented with 2025-26 budget
- Exempts city from permit fee refunds
- SB 5290 Annual Reporting
 - Annual performance report guidance recently released
 - Annual report focused on a sub-set of permits
 - Preliminary and final subdivisions
 - Binding site plans
 - Multifamily housing permits
 - Construction permits for the above referenced permit types
 - Annual report data is available on the <u>city's website</u> and submitted to Dept. of Commerce

2. **City of Bellevue Permit Process**

Preapplication Conference

- Pre-apps required for Critical Use Areas and Short Plats
 - Conditional Use Permit (LB)
 - Shoreline Conditional Use Permit (WA)
 - Preliminary Plat (LL)
 - Preliminary Short Plat (LN)
 - Planned Unit Development (LK)
 - Design Review (LD)
 - Design and Mitigation Permits LUC 20.25.M (Light Rail Overlay District)
 - Critical Areas Land Use Permit (LO)
- New Checklist for Land Use Permits
 - o Details all required submittals requirements
 - Allows staff to waive certain documents/plans
 - Streamlines the submittal process
 - Helps with completeness review and reduces revision cycles
 - The website was update on Jan. 13 and provides a more comprehensive look at each permit type and submittal requirements

 - o Revised submittal requirements on City of Bellevue website
- City of Bellevue Website
 - o <u>Land Use Permit Descriptions</u>
 - Required Documents
 - Single PDF
 - Building Design Documents
 - Site and Infrastructure Documents
 - Bookmarks
 - Document Descriptions
 - o All permits submitted through MyBuildingPermit.com

- Completeness Check
 - Application intake (LUC 20.35.030.C)
 - 28-day completeness review (LUC 20.35.030.D)
 - o Application complete or incomplete
 - Review and revision comments
 - Resubmittal must address revision comments
- How to Ensure Completeness
 - Review city's website
 - Preapplication conference
 - Contact staff to discuss submittal requirements: <u>Development Services</u>
 <u>Department contacts</u>
 - o Schedule virtual meeting to discuss specific submittal requirement
