This NOTICE OF EXCLUSION is to inform you that you are **Excluded from Attendance** at City of Bellevue Planning Commission meetings for **60 days**, from **October 22, 2025** to **December 21, 2025**. During this period of exclusion, you may address the Planning Commission members by submitting written comments to Katherine Nesse, Planning Manager for the Community Development Department and the Planning Commission Liaison. You may submit written comments by United States Mail to 450 – 110th Ave NE, Bellevue, WA 98004 or via email to knesse@bellevuewa.gov, and Dr. Nesse will provide your written comments to each of the Planning Commission members.

This NOTICE OF EXCLUSION shall be posted on the door of Room 1E-113 at Bellevue City Hall on October 21, 2025, where it shall remain posted for the duration of the exclusion period. This NOTICE OF EXCLUSION will also be mailed to you at your last known address, if any, posted on the Planning Commission's web page, filed with the City Clerk, and provided to all Planning Commission members.

REASON FOR EXCLUSION: The City of Bellevue Planning Commission finds that you have repeatedly violated the Bellevue City Code (BCC) 3.64.030.F.1, BCC 3.64.030.F.3, BCC 3.64.030.F.3.a, BCC 3.64.030.F.3.c, BCC 3.64.030.F.3.g, and BCC 3.64.030.F.3.i by engaging in speech or conduct that disrupts, disturbs, or otherwise impedes the orderly conduct of Planning Commission meetings.

For an extended period of time over the past two (2) years, you have violated Bellevue City Code regarding public participation as well as the Rules of Decorum at the following Planning Commission meetings: September 10, 2025, July 9, 2025, June 25, 2025, May 28, 2025, May 14, 2025, April 23, 2025, April 9, 2025, February 26, 2025, January 8, 2025, November 13, 2024, October 9, 2024, June 20, 2024, May 22, 2024, and March 13, 2024. The above-noted violations include when you addressed the Planning Commission while the Planning Commission was in session, without the permission of the Presiding Officer; failed to comply with the rules in BCC 3.64.030.F.1 and BCC 3.64.030.F.3 concerning public comment; failed to comply with the allotted time established for public comments; violated multiple Rules of Decorum in the Planning Commission Bylaws, at Article VII.E; stood in a location or placed a sign in a way that obstructed the view of other Planning Commission meeting attendees; and made speech, expression or outbursts without first being recognized by the Presiding Officer that disrupted, disturbed, and impeded the Planning Commission meetings.

At the above-listed meetings, you were warned by the Presiding Officer that your conduct violated the Bellevue City Code and/or Rules of Decorum. You have also been ejected and/or escorted out from Planning Commission meetings when you continued to violate City Code and the Rules of Decorum despite being warned on September 10, 2025, May 14, 2025, April 23, 2025, April 9, 2025, February 26, 2025, and October 9, 2024. During all Planning Commission meetings identified in this NOTICE OF EXCLUSION, you were told that your conduct violated City Code and the Rules of Decorum in the Planning Commission Bylaws, and your conduct caused actual disruptions and disturbances and impeded the orderly conduct of the Planning Commission meetings.

TO APPEAL THIS EXCLUSION: You may appeal the Exclusion by submitting a written appeal stating the basis for the appeal to the Bellevue City Clerk (450 – 110th Ave NE, Bellevue, WA 98004 or cityclerk@bellevuewa.gov) within six (6) business days after the Notice of Exclusion is posted on the door of Room 1E-113 at Bellevue City Hall. Upon receipt of a timely written appeal, the City Council shall consider the appeal at its next regularly scheduled open public meeting that is at least three (3) business days from the receipt of the appeal. The Exclusion shall remain in effect during the City Council's consideration of any appeal.
