

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Coal Creek Parkway Safety Improvements

November 2025

The City of Bellevue Transportation Department will be starting construction soon on a project on Coal Creek Parkway SE from Factoria Boulevard SE to SE 66th Street to improve safety for people driving. This section of Coal Creek Parkway is on the city's High Injury Network, which is a small number of city streets where most fatal and serious-injury collisions occur. Bellevue's Vision Zero initiative aims to eliminate traffic deaths and serious-injury collisions on city streets by 2030, and providing safety improvements on streets in the High Injury Network is an important part of achieving this goal.



Install two new overhead radar feedback sign installations and two new standard radar feedback signs.



Install new curve warning signs.



Reduce the speed limit to 35 mph from 40 mph and add new speed limit signs

- **Traffic impacts:** There will be impacts to people who travel along Coal Creek Parkway during this project—lane reductions will be needed to complete the work. Stay up to date with traffic impacts by signing up for the city's weekly Traffic Advisories at BellevueWA.gov/traffic-advisories.
- All changes will take place within the existing road, and all vehicle travel lanes will be retained.

Nearby Projects

Please note King County has begun construction on a multi-year sewer upgrade for Bellevue and Newcastle on Coal Creek Parkway from the Red Cedar Trailhead to the intersection of Coal Creek Parkway SE and 119th Ave SE. The project will require intermittent single and double lane closures on Coal Creek Parkway during construction. Funding

This project is fully funded by the federal government with a Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) grant. The total estimated cost is \$987,000.

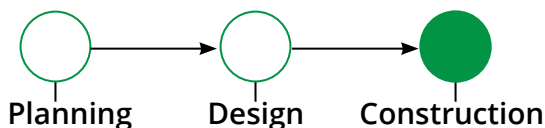

What to expect

- **Construction schedule:** Construction is anticipated to start in November 2025 and last through spring 2026
- **Work hours:** Work will take place from 7 a.m.-3 p.m. in the southbound direction and 9 a.m.-5 p.m. in the northbound direction, Monday to Friday



City of Bellevue 的 Transportation Department 即将在 Coal Creek Parkway SE (从 Factoria Boulevard SE 至 SE 66th Street 路段) 启动一个施工项目, 旨在提升驾车者行车安全性。Coal Creek Parkway 路段位于本市的高伤亡事故道路网络 (High Injury Network), 该网络中的城市街道数量虽少, 却是大多数致命和严重伤害碰撞事故的发生地点。Bellevue 的 Vision Zero 计划旨在到 2030 年消除城市街道上的交通死亡和严重伤害碰撞事故, 而改善高伤亡事故道路网络中街道的安全是实现这一目标的重要组成部分。

该项目计划：

- 安装两个新的高架雷达反馈标志装置和两个新的标准雷达反馈标志
- 安装新的弯道警告标志
- 将限速从 40 英里/小时降低至 35 英里/小时, 并增设新的限速标志

预期情况：

- 施工进度：施工预计于 2025 年 11 月开始, 持续到 2026 年春季
- 施工时间：施工将在周一至周五进行, 南向车道施工时间为上午 7 点至下午 3 点, 北向车道施工时间为 9 点至下午 5 点
- 影响：在此项目期间, 沿 Coal Creek Parkway 行驶的车辆将受到影响——为完成施工, 在此期间将需要减少车道。请访问 BellevueWA.gov/traffic-advisories 注册订阅本市每周发布的 Traffic Advisories, 及时了解交通影响的最新信息。

City of Bellevue 的 Transportation Department 即将在 Coal Creek Parkway SE (从 Factoria Boulevard SE 至 SE 66th Street 路段) 启动一项施工专案, 旨在提升驾驶者行车安全。Coal Creek Parkway 路段位于本市的高伤亡事故道路网络 (High Injury Network), 这是市内少数发生大多数致命及重伤事故的街道之一。Bellevue 的 Vision Zero 计划旨在於 2030 年消除城市街道上的交通死亡和重伤碰撞事故, 而改善高伤亡事故道路网络中街道的安全是实现这一目标的重要一环。

该专案将：

- 安装两个新的高架雷达回馈标志装置及两个新的标准雷达回馈标志

City of Bellevue Transportation Department (運輸局) は運転者の安全を改善するためにCoal Creek Parkway SEのFactoria Boulevard SEからSE 66th Streetまでの区間のプロジェクトに対する工事をすぐ始める予定です。Coal Creek Parkwayのこの区間は、最も致命的で重大な負傷を起こす衝突事故が発生する、市内の少数の道路である当市のHigh Injury Network (高負傷率ネットワーク) 内に位置しています。Bellevue のVision Zeroイニシアチブは2030年まで市の道路で交通事故による死亡と重大な負傷を起こす衝突事故を無くすことを目標としており、High Injury Networkに位置する道路に安全改善を提供することはこの目標を達成するための重要な部分です。

本プロジェクトは以下を行います：

- 二つの新しいオーバヘッドレーダーフィードバック標識の設置物と二つの新しい標準レーダーフィードバック標識を設置する
- 新しいカーブあり注意標識を設置する
- 制限速度を40mph (64.4kmh) から35mph (56.3kmh) へ減らし、新しい制限速度標識を追加

予測されること：

- 工事スケジュール工事は2025年11月に開始され、2026年春まで続く予定です。
- 工事時間：工事は月曜日から金曜日まで行い、南行きの方向は午前7時から午後3時まで、北行きの方向は午前9時から午後5時まで行います。
- 影響：工事を完了するには車線の数を減らす必要がありますので、このプロジェクト中にはCoal Creek Parkwayに沿って移動する人々に影響がある予定です。BellevueWA.gov/traffic-advisoriesをご覧ください、市の週間Traffic Advisories (交通アドバイザー) に登録して交通影響に関する最新情報をご確認ください。

City of Bellevue Transportation Department(교통부)는 Factoria Boulevard SE에서 SE 66th Street까지의 구간에 해당하는 Coal Creek Parkway SE의 운전자 안전을 개선하기 위한 프로젝트에 대한 공사를 곧 시작할 예정입니다. Coal Creek Parkway의 이 구간은 치명적이고 중대한 부상을 유발하는 충돌사고가 발생하는 시내의 소수 도로인 시의 High Injury Network(고부상을 네트워크)에 위치하고 있습니다. Bellevue의 Vision Zero 이니셔티브는 2030년까지 시의 도로에서 교통으로 인한 사망 및 중상을 유발하는 충돌사고를 없애는 것을 목표로 하며, High Injury Network에 위치한 도로에 안전개선을 제공하는 것은 이 목표를 달성하기 위한 중요한 부분입니다.

프로젝트 내용:

- 두 개의 새로운 오버헤드 레이더 피드백 표지판 설치물 및 두 개의 새로운 표준 레이더 피드백 표지판을 설치
- 새로운 커브길 주의 표지판 설치
- 제한속도를 40mph(64.4kmh)에서 35mph(56.3kmh)로 줄이고 새로운 제한속도 표지판을 추가

예상되는 사항:

- 공사 일정: 공사는 2025년 11월에 시작되어 2026년 봄까지 계속될 것으로 예상됩니다
- 공사 시간: 공사는 월요일부터 금요일까지 진행되며, 남쪽방향으로의 작업은 오전 7시부터 오후 3시까지, 북쪽방향으로의 작업은 오전 9시부터 오후 5시까지입니다.

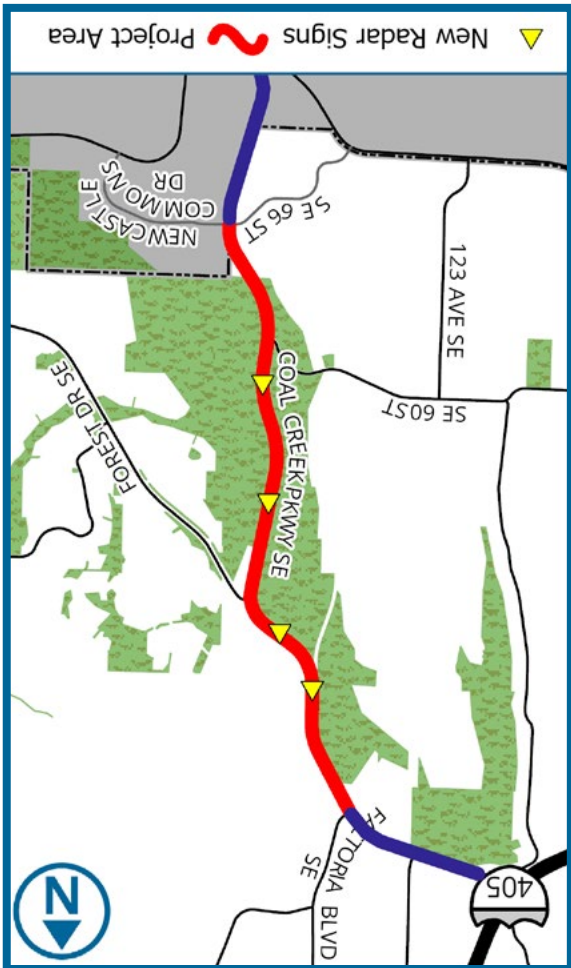
