

Hate Crimes and Bias Incidents – 2025

A **hate crime** involves the suspect committing a crime motivated by the suspects perception of the victim’s race, color, sexual orientation etc. and a **bias incident** is an act of prejudice that is not criminal and does not involve threats, violence, or property damage. A bias incident may include yelling profanity and insults, distributing racist flyers in public places, and displaying hateful materials on private property.

In 2025 there were 10 hate crimes (criminal) and 1 bias incident (non-criminal) reported.

The hate crimes and bias incident reported in 2025 were as follows:
