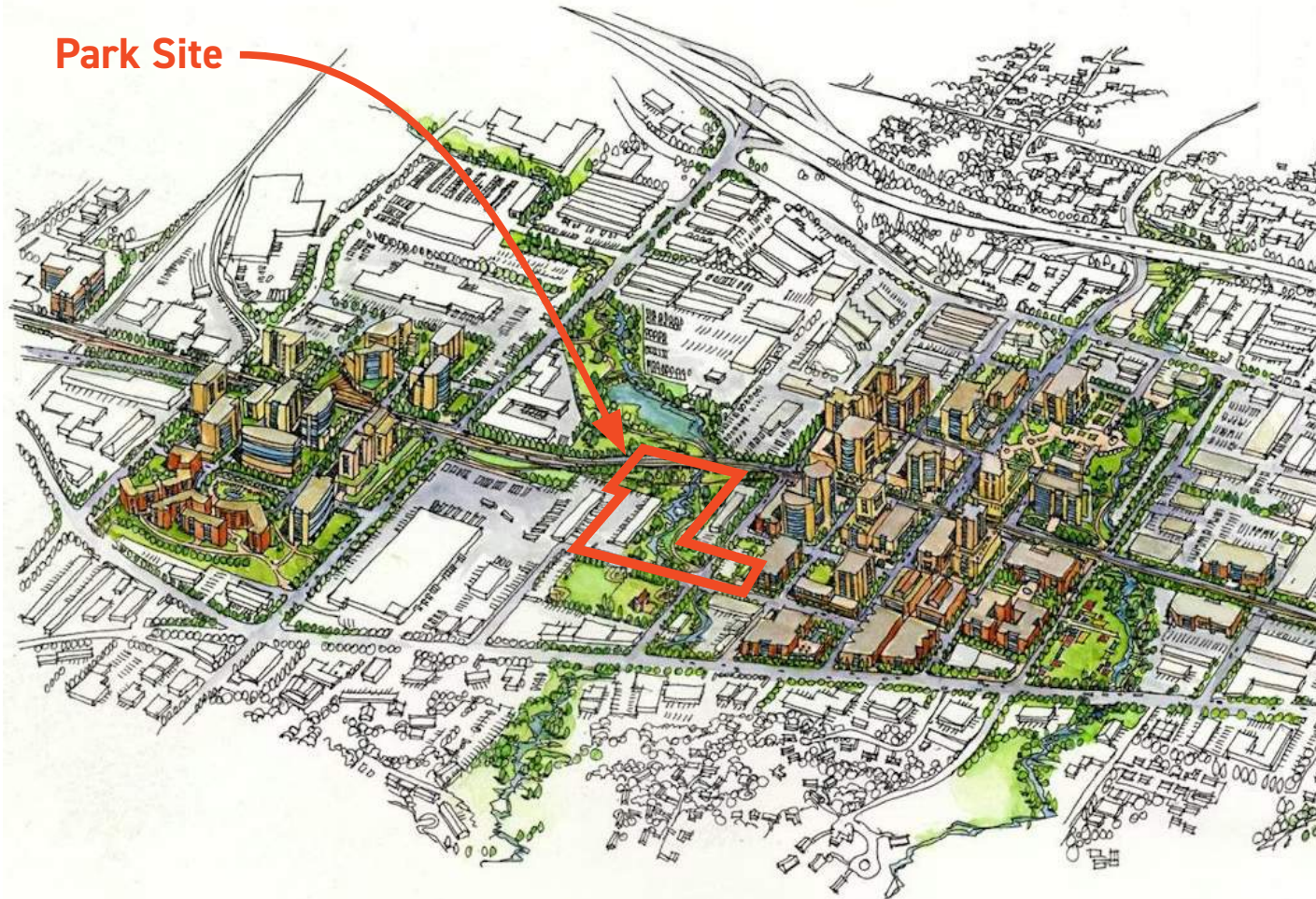

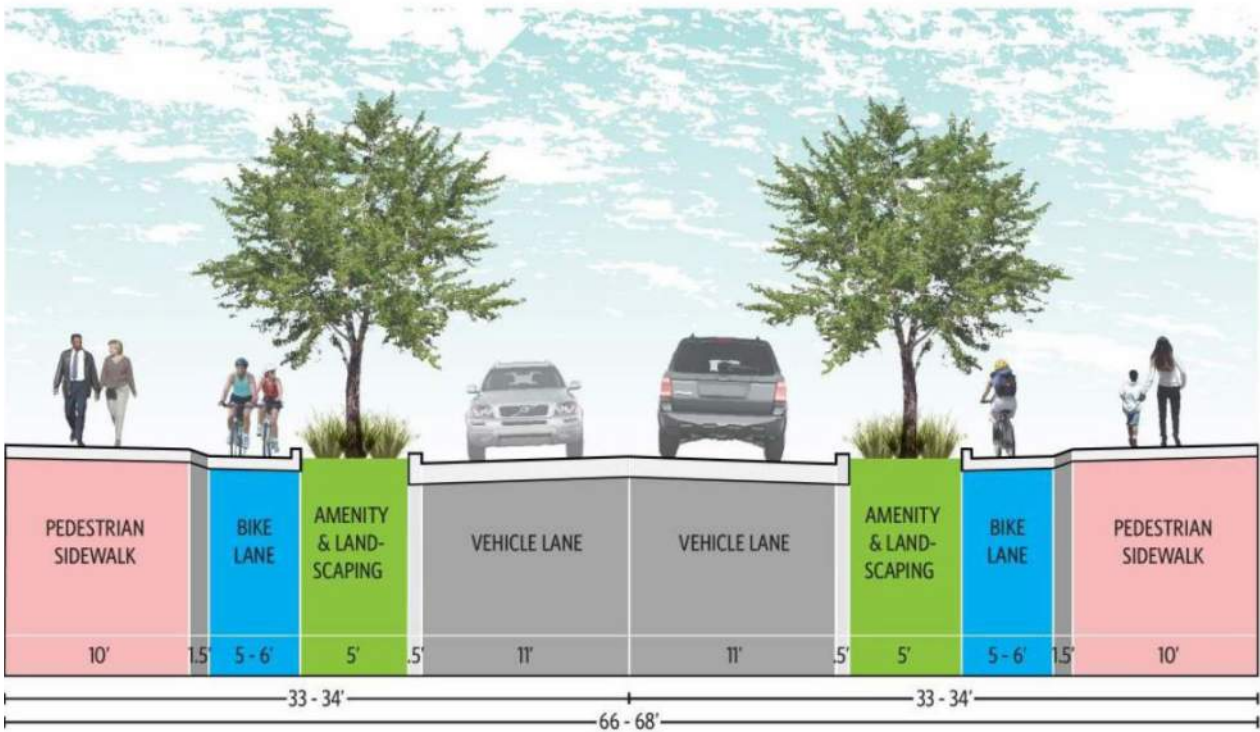
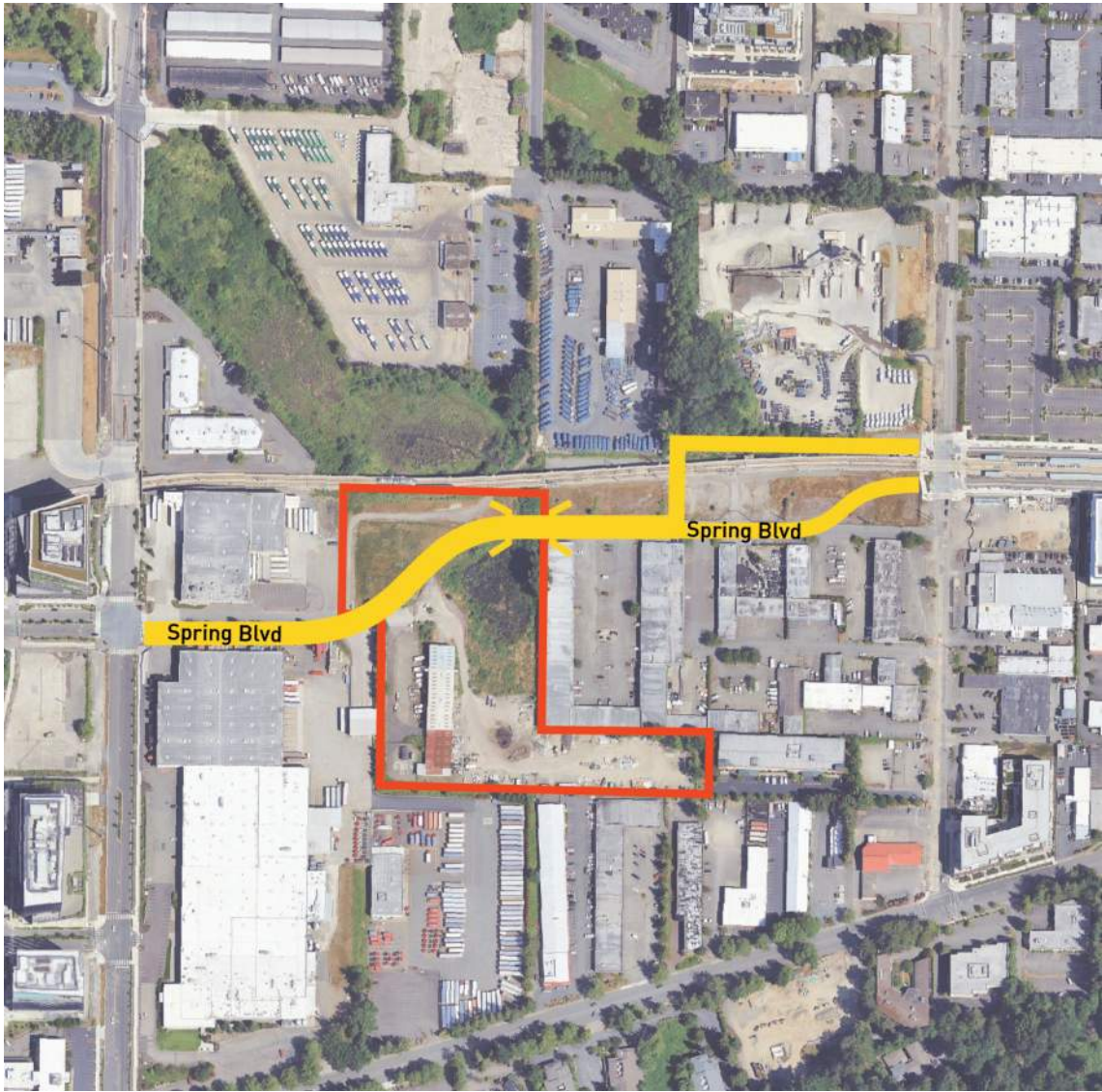

- Seating areas to rest in nature

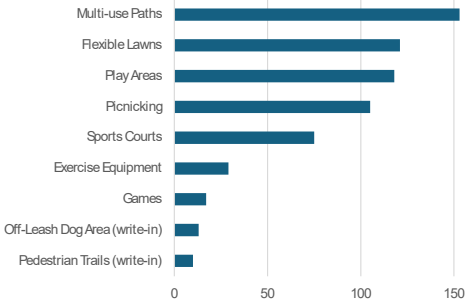
What types of play and recreation amenities would you like in the new park?

- Walking/biking trail that connects to other trails

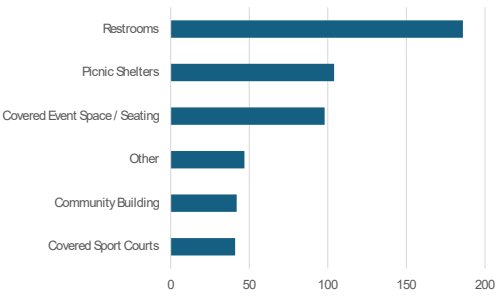
What types of cultural programming would you like to see in the park?

- Whimsical - odd thigns you can see in the city, small and secret

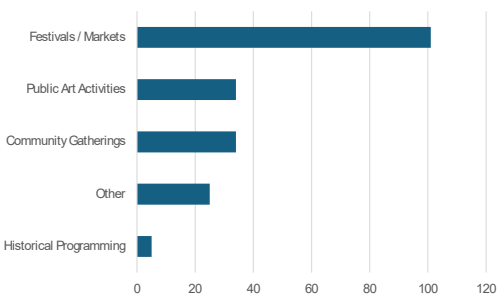
