## PROJECT OVERVIEW

The NE Spring Boulevard Zone 3 project is intended to make an important east-west connection to improve access, circulation, and mobility options for passenger cars, transit, pedestrians, and bicycles between Bel-Red development nodes. It connects the existing east and west segments of Spring Boulevard and will result in a complete corridor from downtown Bellevue through the revitalized Bel-Red area.

The Project is at 30% Design and is advancing design and environmental permitting approvals. The project is currently funded for design only through a federal grant. The project may be constructed in phases due to the size and complexity of the corridor.

## WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF THIS PROJECT?

- ✓ Completes the connection of the Spring Boulevard Roadway spine through BelRed
- ✓ Increased access for people walking, biking and rolling through BelRed
- ✓ Separates non-motorized users from vehicular traffic
- ✓ Provides access to the future BelRed Park
- ✓ Increased access between Spring District and BelRed light rail stations
- ✓ Bridge over West Tributary to Kelsey Creek
- ✓ Compatible with the future street grid network in BelRed
