



New speed safety cameras coming soon

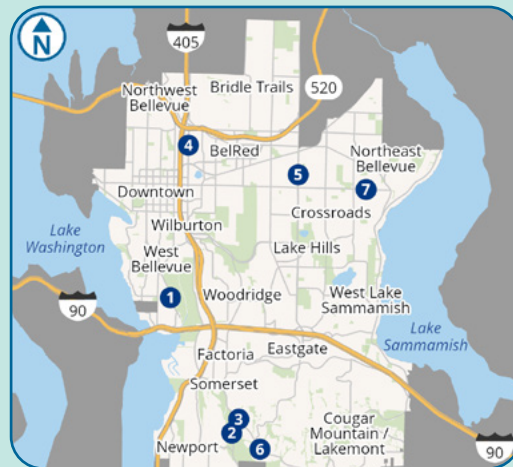
This summer, the City of Bellevue Transportation Department will install speed safety cameras at seven locations across the city.

Cameras will be activated gradually across the seven locations between August and the end of the year.

Each location will include advance warning signage and will begin with a 30-day warning period before citations are issued. Camera status provided at BellevueWA.gov/speed-safety-cameras.

A citation may be issued when a vehicle exceeds the posted speed limit by 8 mph or more. Under Washington State law, citations are issued to the registered owner of the vehicle.

The cameras are designed to reduce speeding and improve safety as part of Bellevue's Vision Zero commitment to eliminate traffic deaths and serious injuries by 2030.
