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10	<b>Non-SWF Equipment.</b> Does the SWF Application include the construction or installation of any Proposed Equipment which is not a “SWF” or “Small Wireless Facility” as defined in BCC 6.02 and BCC 6.08 (“Non-SWF Equipment”) (Yes/No, if yes explain) (if yes, then 150 day shot clock)	
11	<b>Batching.</b> Is the SWF Application “batched”? A SWF Application is “batched” if it includes: (i) more than physical location such as more than one Pole; or (ii) one Pole plus Ground-based equipment; or (iii) one Pole (not being replaced) plus a replacement pole	
12	<b>Batch List.</b> If batched, then attach a list of all City Poles in the batch. Attach additional pages if needed.	
13	<b>Mixed Batch.</b> If batched, is it a “mixed batch”? A batch is “mixed” if it includes one or more requests for: (i) replacement pole; or (ii) Ground-based equipment; or (iii) a new pole which does not replace (within 10 feet) an existing City Pole? (For mixed batch, shot clock for all requests is 90 days).
