Council Input Needed – Appropriate CUP Process

What type of Conditional Use Permit process should be used?

- Appeal Option to Council (Type I) OR
- Automatic consideration by Council (Type III)

Council Input Needed – Mechanism to Apply Light Rail Best Practices

Should "Expectations of Sound Transit" in the Light Rail Best Practices Report be applicable to light rail design and mitigation permits through either:

- Decision criterion that requires consistency with the Comprehensive Plan OR
- Restating those expectations in the Overlay?

Procedural Sections – Who May Apply

- Draft Code: A regional transit authority with condemnation authority could apply for permits prior to completing acquisition of the underlying property.
- Same process that applies to other agencies and public utilities that have condemnation authority (e.g., City of Bellevue, PSE)

Procedural Sections – Administrative Modification Process

- Strict application of LUC not always feasible or practical
- GMA limits application of policies and regulations that would preclude Essential Public Facilities
- Modification of code provisions could be allowed if:
 - Minimum necessary in accordance with Best Practices Report to make construction or operation practicable and feasible; OR
 - Reasonably necessary to implement or ensure consistency with other Council-related actions such Development Agreement provisions, cost saving alternatives, or Street Design Standards amendments.

Council Input Needed – Notice to Property Owners

Should the Overlay include notice requirements that must be met before permits applications are submitted for any light rail components located on property not yet acquired by Sound Transit or the City?

Council Input Needed – Process Merger/Consolidation

Should any CUP application for light rail alignment permits be required to be consolidated or merged with the design and mitigation permit?

What Station Design process should be used?

- Administrative Design Review (Type II) OR
- Council Design Review (i.e., Ped Bridges)
