The Bellevue Fire Department annually inspects all structures, except single family homes within our service area (Beaux Arts Village, Bellevue, Clyde Hill, Hunts Point, Medina, Newcastle and Yarrow Point) in order to identify and correct fire code deficiencies.

MyBuildingPermit.com is a regional governmental web site that makes accessing this inspection information and a wealth of other related information a snap.

Has a building been inspected recently?

The answer is a few key strokes and clicks away:

Choose "Research Permits"





- **3.** Enter the search parameters:
 - Jurisdiction = Bellevue (includes Beaux Arts Village, Clyde Hill, Hunts Point, Medina, Newcastle & Yarrow Point)
 - Permit Type = RI (annual Inspection) or RV (violations)
 - House Number = address numbers
 - Street Name = e.g. Main Street



Results returned are high level; details are available by clicking on the hyperlinks.

Are there violations?

If the status of the RI permit = violations, then there are current, uncorrected violations. Use the same address and year, and "RV" (violations) for the permit type and then click on the permit number will reveal the code violations



Once the code violations have been corrected, the permit status will change to "closed".


Other Uses
