Project staff will have displays of the proposed improvements to the trail. It will be an opportunity for you to ask questions and provide your comments on various potential trail features.

11 a.m. – 12 noon Crossroads Trail, north entrance, on Northup Way.

Take a tour of the trail, starting at the north end (near the LDS church). Learn about proposed improvements and ask in-depth questions of staff, as you walk the trail from the north end to the south end of the project.



Project Description & Need: This trail needs to be improved, updated and repaired for the safety and convenience of those who use it (or would like to). In the past, there has been frequent graffiti on the fence bordering the trail and pedestrians have experienced a narrow and uneven surface in several sections of the trail.

Planned Improvements: Project staff have been working on how to improve the trail surface, fencing, landscaping, lighting and maintenance. In addition, several trees may be removed. At the south end, the trail will be extended through the Crossroads Apartments parking lot and connect to NE 15th Street.

Project Schedule: Final design of the trail improvements will take place this summer. Construction is expected to occur in Spring 2019.
