WRPA honors public agencies and individuals for outstanding and unique achievements. Park and recreation professionals, facilities, special programs, and media materials from throughout Washington state were recognized during an awards ceremony at the WRPA Annual Conference & Trade Show on Wednesday, April 17, 2013 in Vancouver, WA.

Terry Smith, Assistant Director of Parks & Community Services, was awarded the **Citation of Merit – Professional** award recognizing his long-time commitment to providing services for youth, people with disabilities, and the general community.
