EAST BELLEVUE COMMUNITY MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON RESOLUTION NO. 117

A RESOLUTION of the East Bellevue Community Council approving Ordinance No. 2634 adopted by the Bellevue City Council relating to the final plans of Phase II of the Mainroads Planned Residential Unit Development and Planned Unit Development, located at the northeast corner of Main Street and 148th Avenue N.E., in the City of Bellevue.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bellevue, Washington, did pass Ordinance No. 2634 on the 16th day of October, 1978, and

Section 1. The findings, conclusions and conditions adopted by the Bellevue City Council relative to the final plans of Phase II of the Mainroads Planned Residential Unit Development and Planned Unit Development, located at the northeast corner of Main Street and 148th Avenue N.E., in the City of Bellevue, are hereby adopted by the East Bellevue Community Council as though fully set forth herein.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 2634 of the Bellevue City Council is hereby approved.

Section 3. The Clerk is hereby directed to certify the original of this resolution, to file the same and to keep the same on file in her office. The Clerk is further directed to distribute certified or conformed copies of this resolution to the Bellevue City Council and the Bellevue Planning Department.
