## Resolution No. 279

A RESOLUTION of the East Bellevue Community Council approving City Council Ordinance No. 4066, relating to conditional use, shoreline conditional use, and administrative conditional use permit modification procedures; amending Bellevue City Code (Land Use Code) Chapter 20.30B, 20.30C, 20.30E and 20.50.040, and adding Sections 20.30B.165, 20.30B.170, 20.30C.105, 20.30C.200, 20.30E.165 and 20.30E.170

WHEREAS, on the 23rd day of October, 1989 the City Council of the City of Bellevue, Washington passed Ordinance No. 4066, relating to conditional use, shoreline conditional use, and administrative conditional use permit modification procedures; and
