Resolution No. 338

A RESOLUTION of the East Bellevue Community Council approving City Council Resolution No. 5652, relating to the Transportation/Circulation Element of the Comprehensive Plan; repealing Section 21.M.215, Roadway Network-Non-Motorized Transportation; repealing Section 21.M.500 (Maps A., B., C., and C.a); adding a new Section 21.M.215, Pedestrian and Bicycle Transportation Policies; and adding a new Section 21.M.500 (Maps A. and B.) to Chapter 21.M of the Comprehensive Plan.

WHEREAS, on the 17th day of May, 1993 the City Council of the City of Bellevue, Washington passed Resolution No. 5652, relating to the Pedestrian and Bicycle Transportation Policies; and

WHEREAS, the subject matter of said Resolution falls within the jurisdiction of the East Bellevue Community Council pursuant to RCW 35.14.040; and

WHEREAS, following a public hearing held before the East Bellevue Community Council on June 1, 1993, the Community Council voted to approve Bellevue Resolution No. 5652;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Community Council of the East Bellevue Community Municipal Corporation of the City of Bellevue:

Section 1: Resolution No. 5652 of the Bellevue City Council is hereby approved.

Section 2: The Clerk is hereby directed to certify the original of this Resolution, to file the same and to keep the same on file in her office. The Clerk is further directed to distribute certified or conformed copies of this Resolution to the Bellevue City Council, the Bellevue Planning Department, and the Department of Design and Development.
