Resolution No. 358

A RESOLUTION of the East Bellevue Community Council approving City Council Ordinance No. 4694, reclassifying seven (7) parcels totaling 209.30 acres located within the area south of NE 8th Street and north of the Lake Hills Connector, east of 130th Avenue NE and west of 136th Avenue NE (Kelsey Creek Park and the Glendale Country Club) from OU to R-1 on application of the City of Bellevue, and known as Kelsey/Richard Creek KRC 1-B Rezone Project.

WHEREAS, on the 19th day of September, 1994 the City Council of the City of Bellevue, Washington passed Ordinance No. 4694, reclassifying property in Kelsey Creek Park and the Glendale Country Club; and

WHEREAS, the subject matter of said Ordinance falls within the jurisdiction of the East Bellevue Community Council pursuant to RCW 35.14.040; and

WHEREAS, following a public hearing held before the East Bellevue Community Council on October 4, 1994, the Community Council voted to approve Bellevue Ordinance No. 4694;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Community Council of the East Bellevue Community Municipal Corporation of the City of Bellevue:

Section 1: The Findings, Conclusions and Conditions adopted by the Bellevue City Council relative to Ordinance No. 4694 are hereby adopted by the East Bellevue Community Council as though fully set forth herein.

Section 2: Ordinance No. 4694 of the Bellevue City Council is hereby approved.

Section 3: The Clerk is hereby directed to certify the original of this Resolution, to file the same and to keep the same on file in her office. The Clerk is further directed to distribute certified or conformed copies of this Resolution to the Bellevue City Council, the Office of Policy Planning, and the Department of Community Development.
