Resolution No. 363

A RESOLUTION of the East Bellevue Community Council approving City Council Ordinance No. 4771, reclassifying 69.5 acres located generally north of Main Street and east of 136th Avenue N.E. extending in places as far north as N.E. 8th Street and as far east as 143rd Avenue N.E., from R-1.8 and P0 to R-2.5 on application of the City of Bellevue and known as the Wilburton/N.E. 8th Street - 16 Rezone Project

WHEREAS, on the 26th day of June, 1995 the City Council of the City of Bellevue, Washington passed Ordinance No. 4771, reclassifying an area known as the Wilburton/N.E. 8th Street - 16 Rezone Project; and

WHEREAS, the subject matter of said Ordinance falls within the jurisdiction of the East Bellevue Community Council pursuant to RCW 35.14.040; and

WHEREAS, following a public hearing held before the East Bellevue Community Council on August 1, 1995, the Community Council voted to approve Bellevue Ordinance No. 4771;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Community Council of the East Bellevue Community Municipal Corporation of the City of Bellevue:

Section 1: The Findings, Conclusions and Conditions adopted by the Bellevue City Council relative to Ordinance No. 4771 are hereby adopted by the East Bellevue Community Council as though fully set forth herein.

Section 2: Ordinance No. 4771 of the Bellevue City Council is hereby approved.

Section 3: The Clerk is hereby directed to certify the original of this Resolution, to file the same and to keep the same on file in her office. The Clerk is further directed to distribute certified or conformed copies of this Resolution to the Bellevue City Council, the Planning Department, and the Department of Community Development.
