A RESOLUTION relative to traffic safety on
145th Place S.E., from S.E. 10th to S.E. 16th.

WHEREAS, the East Bellevue Community Council of the City of Bellevue, Washington, has long been concerned with the hazardous conditions on 145th Place S.E., from S.E. 10th to S.E. 16th, and

WHEREAS, the East Bellevue Community Council believes the safe accommodation of motorized, non-motorized and pedestrian modes is imperative, and,

WHEREAS, the East Bellevue Community Council unanimously supports the proposal by the Department of Public Works, as outlined in their letter of October 13, 1975 to Mr. T. T. McLeod of the Washington State Highway Department (Topics Project No. T-7103-11), now therefore,

THE EAST BELLEVUE COMMUNITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Public Works plan for improvements on 145th Place S.E., from S.E. 10 to S.E. 16th (Topics Project No. T-7103-11) is hereby approved and supported.

Section 2. The City is hereby urged to take immediate action to implement the proposed improvements.


Section 3. The Clerk is hereby directed to certify the original of this resolution, to file the same, and to keep the same on file in her office.
