RESOLUTION NO. 77

A RESOLUTION approving City Council Resolution No. 2599 relating to amendments to the Bellevue Comprehensive Plan and adding new policies thereto.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bellevue, Washington, did pass Resolution No. 2599 on the 6th day of October, 1975, and,

WHEREAS, said resolution relates to amendments to the Bellevue Comprehensive Plan and adds new policies thereto, and,

WHEREAS, after due study and deliberation, in a public meeting held November 11, 1975, the East Bellevue Community Council of the City of Bellevue, Washington, finds Resolution No. 2599 to be in the best interest of the residents of the East Bellevue Community Municipal Corporation, now therefore,

THE EAST BELLEVUE COMMUNITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. City Council Resolution No. 2599 is hereby approved with the understanding that the following clerical errors and minor omissions will be corrected in the ultimate publication:

- (1) On Page 1, in the first paragraph in Definitions, should be changed to read, "...number of dwelling units per acre of developed..."
- (2) On Page 2, asterisks should be added as follows, Medium Density* High Rise and High Density* High Rise.
- (3) On Page 3, under Open Use Residential, the following clause should be added, "must maintain 90% of the land in an open or essentially natural state."
- (4) On Page 3, XXI.B.000., the words "single family" should be added as follows, "...uses other than single family residential..."


Section 2. The Clerk is hereby directed to certify the original of this resolution, to file the same, and to keep the same on file in her office.
