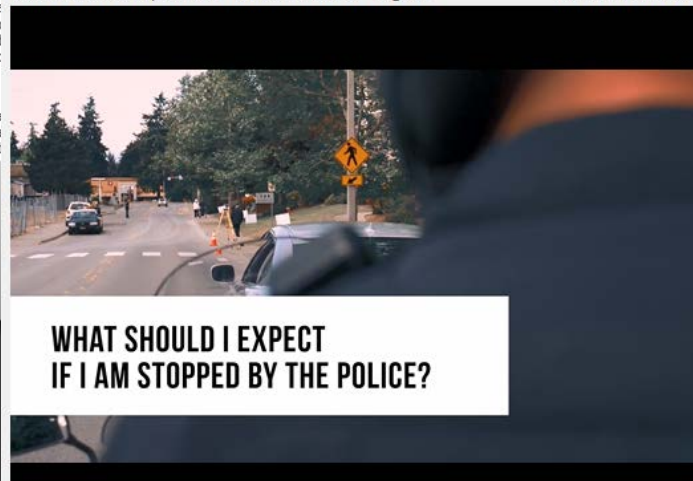
En primer lugar, un Oficial puede preguntarle su país de ciudadanía y la oportunidad de representar a su país en los juegos olímpicos.

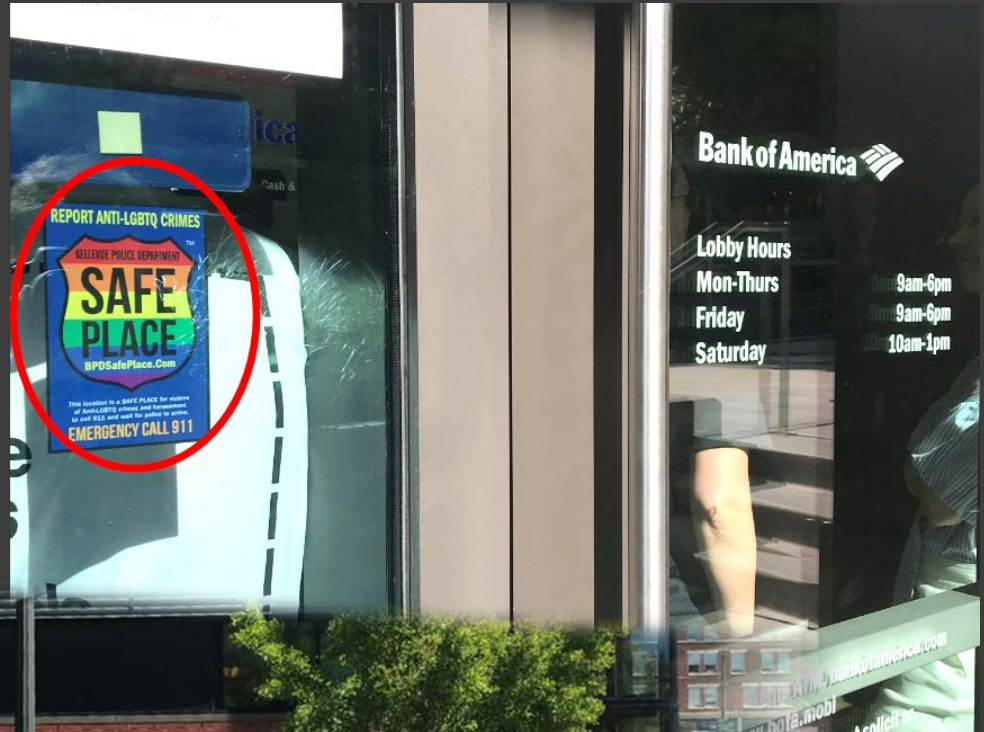

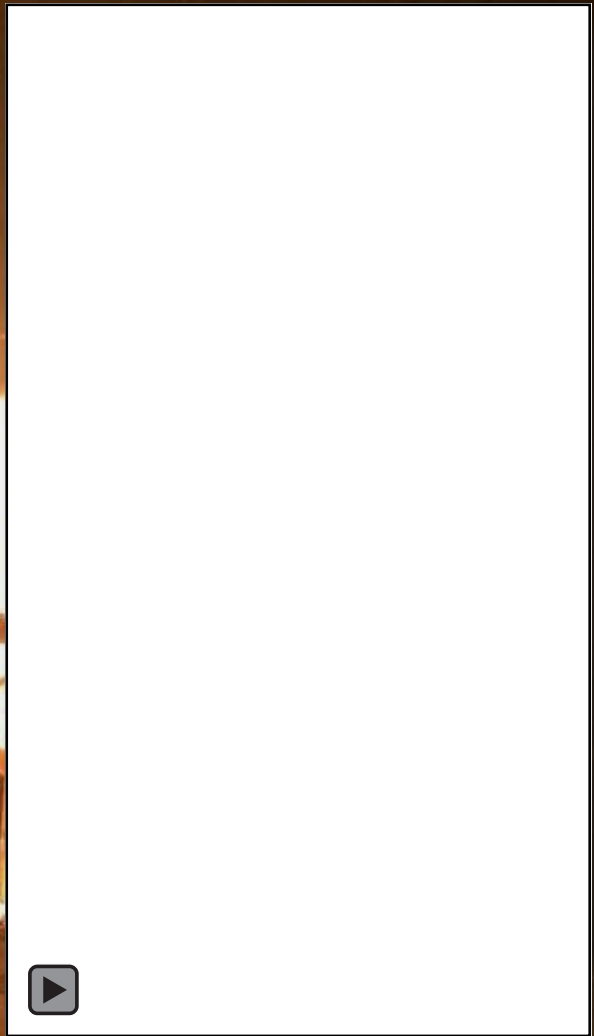

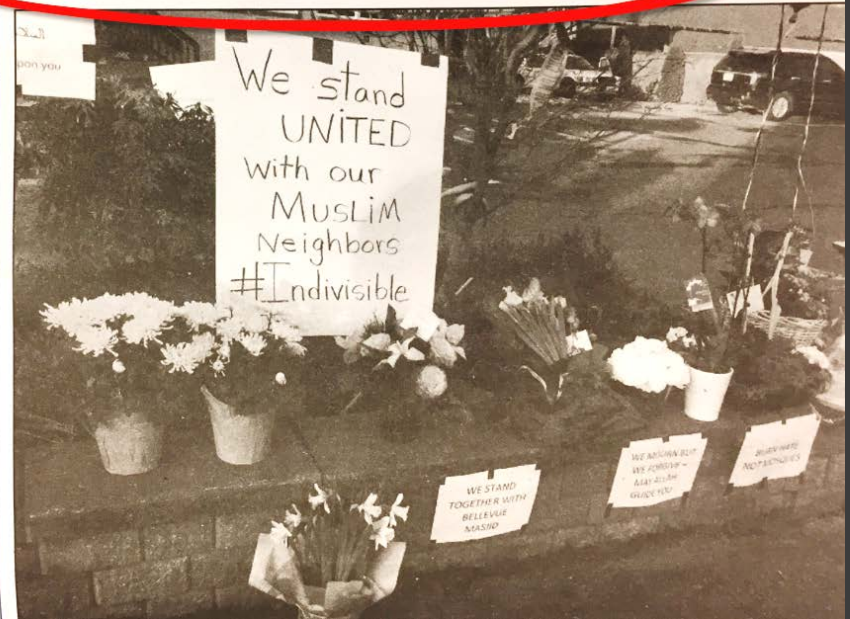

Advisory Council Purpose

- **Strengthen the relationship** between BPD and the community. Built on trust, respect, and mutual understanding.
- **Identify barriers** between police officers and members of the community. Develop strategies to eliminate the barriers.
- **Establish an environment** that promotes dialogue, education, and a true partnership. Enable our citizens to report crimes.
- **Advise the Chief** on best approaches/practices. Make deposits in the TBA (Trust Bank Account) to build support.
- **Identify venues** for delivering on-going presentations and Q and As.
- **Develop strategies** to increase representation of the community within the ranks of BPD. Identify best methods and locations to recruit.
- **ID best methods of communication** and pitfalls that could impact the relationship.
- **In times of turmoil**, advise the Chief on best approaches to defuse the situation. Transparency.
