Introduction

The City of Bellevue published a Vision Zero <u>webpage</u> that includes access to an on-line <u>crash</u> <u>map</u> for interactive searching of fatal and serious injury collisions on Bellevue streets over a 10-year period. This memo and the links provided are for your information only - no action requested at this time.

Background

Guided by Council's <u>Program Principles</u> and the <u>PBII Scope of Work</u>, the Transportation Commission and staff are working with community stakeholders on an action-oriented initiative that will identify the strategy the City of Bellevue should pursue today to advance the projects and programs identified in the <u>2009 Pedestrian and Bicycle Transportation Plan</u>.

At its October 13, 2016 meeting, staff reviewed with the Commission PBII progress and next steps in the work program. Highlighted in slide 21 of the <u>staff presentation</u> was a commitment to produce a Vision Zero Crash Map consistent with PBII Task 1.

The Vision Zero Crash Map will be updated annually to document where, when, and what type of collisions are taking place in Bellevue. Strategies needed to accomplish Vision Zero's ambitious goals of zero fatalities and serious injuries by 2030 will be further developed in collaboration with the Transportation Commission and City Council.
