



W. LAKE SAM PKWY IMPROVEMENTS

- Completion of West Lake Sammamish improvements: traffic signals, sidewalk, bike lane & crosswalks
- Along parkway; SE 34th Street and SE 26th Street intersections
- Transportation to begin community process in 2018 to develop alternatives for West Lake Sammamish Parkway Ph. 2 improvements

W. LAKE SAM PKWY REPAVING

- Pot holes and uneven pavement
- Utilities to replace drinking water pipe on Parkway, roughly between NE 7th and SE 18th Streets, in late 2017
- Utilities will repave affected portions and Transportation will evaluate remaining portions for repairs, as necessary

- Several requests throughout area
- Cost exceeds NEP
- Transportation to coordinate future planning and funding opportunities
- Capital Investment Program is primary source of funding

LAKE SAMMAMISH PARK

- Open Lake Sammamish Park property to the public; provide access to water & basic park features
- Requires special permit
- No Park Master Plan exists
