

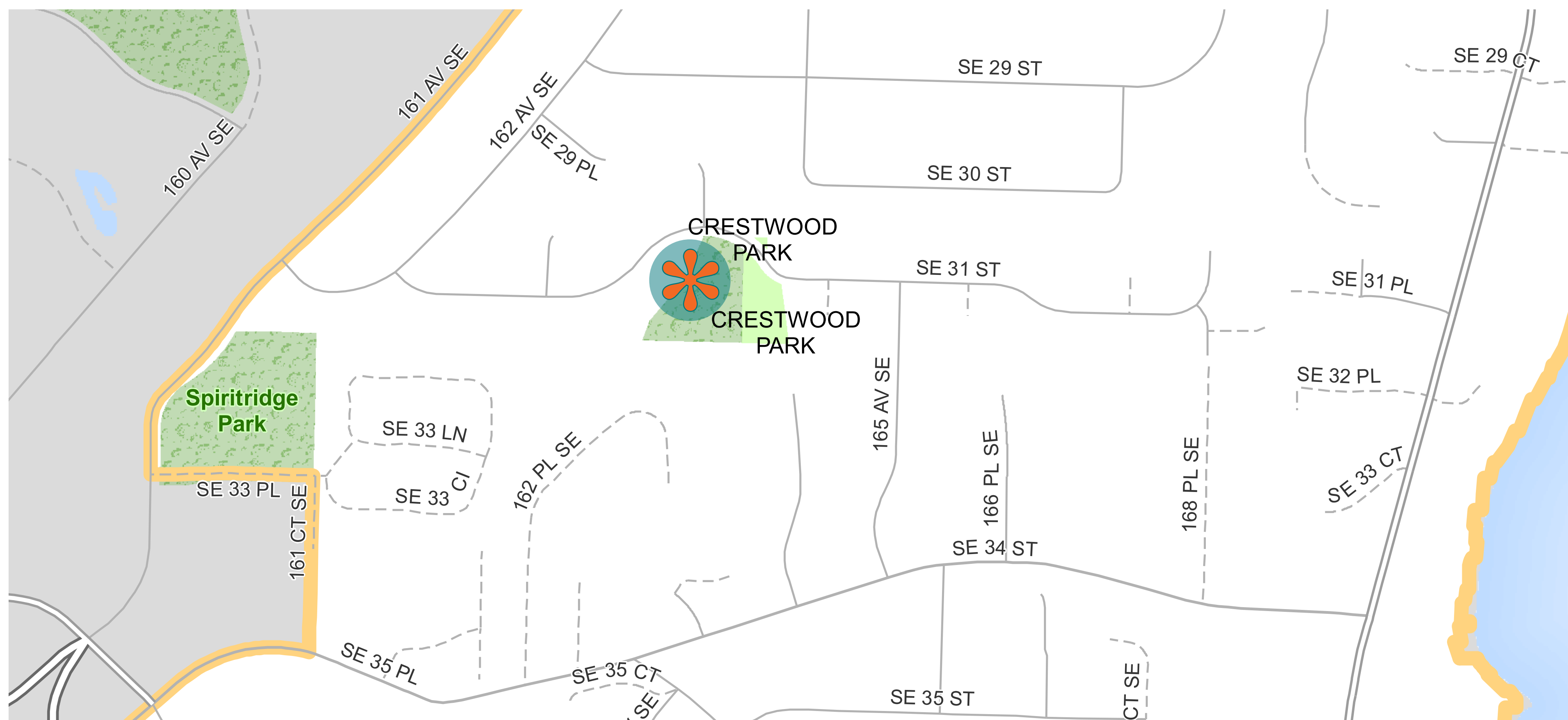
WLS-1 CRESTWOOD TRAIL

WEST LAKE SAMMAMISH



cost \$10,300

location Crestwood Open Space



description This project would install a four foot-wide, multi-use pedestrian trail through the Crestwood Open Space Property, from the intersection of 163rd Place SE and SE 31st Street, to 162nd Place SE. This project would bring an existing social trail into compliance with City of Bellevue trail standards, as well as provide two wayfinding trail bollards, a Mutt Mitt dog waste station and a trash can.



WLS-2 SUNRISE PARK KIOSK

WEST LAKE SAMMAMISH



cost \$35,000

location Sunrise Park



description This project would provide an informational kiosk, a bike rack, a park bench, a trash can and additional native plants at the Sunrise Park Trailhead. The trailhead provides access to a multipurpose pedestrian and bicycle trail, and these enhancements would offer users seasonal park information, a trail system map, bike parking, a place to rest, and a waste receptacle for keeping the trail clean.



WLS-3 PICKLEBALL COURT

WEST LAKE SAMMAMISH



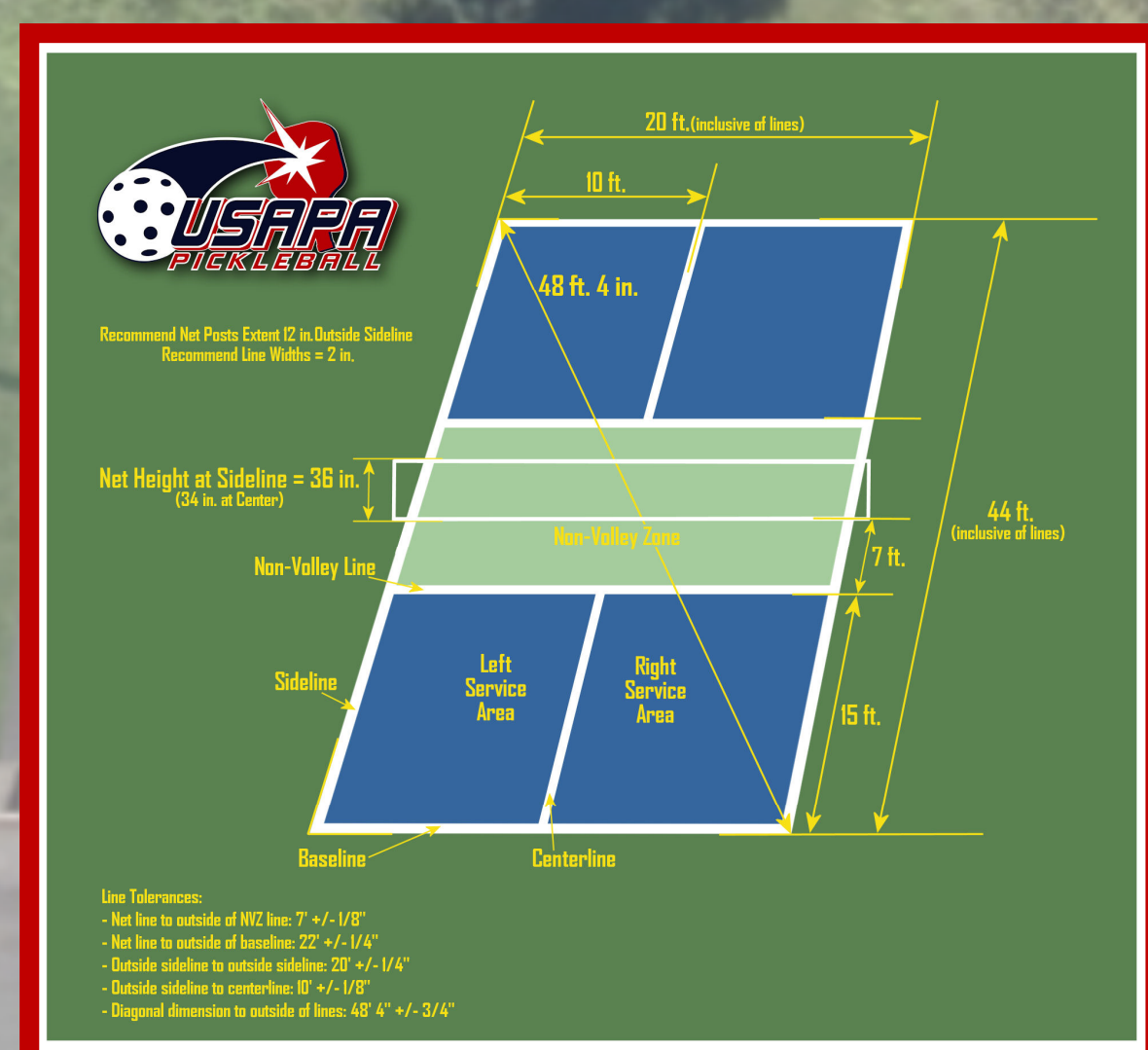
cost \$700

location Spiritridge Park



description This project would provide pickleball line striping to the existing tennis court at Spiritridge Park. The tennis court would be powerwashed and striped with pickleball lines, and the adjustable net would remain at the same level.

- Existing tennis court surface to be cleaned.
- Line striping to be painted over cleaned surface.
- Net is currently adjustable.



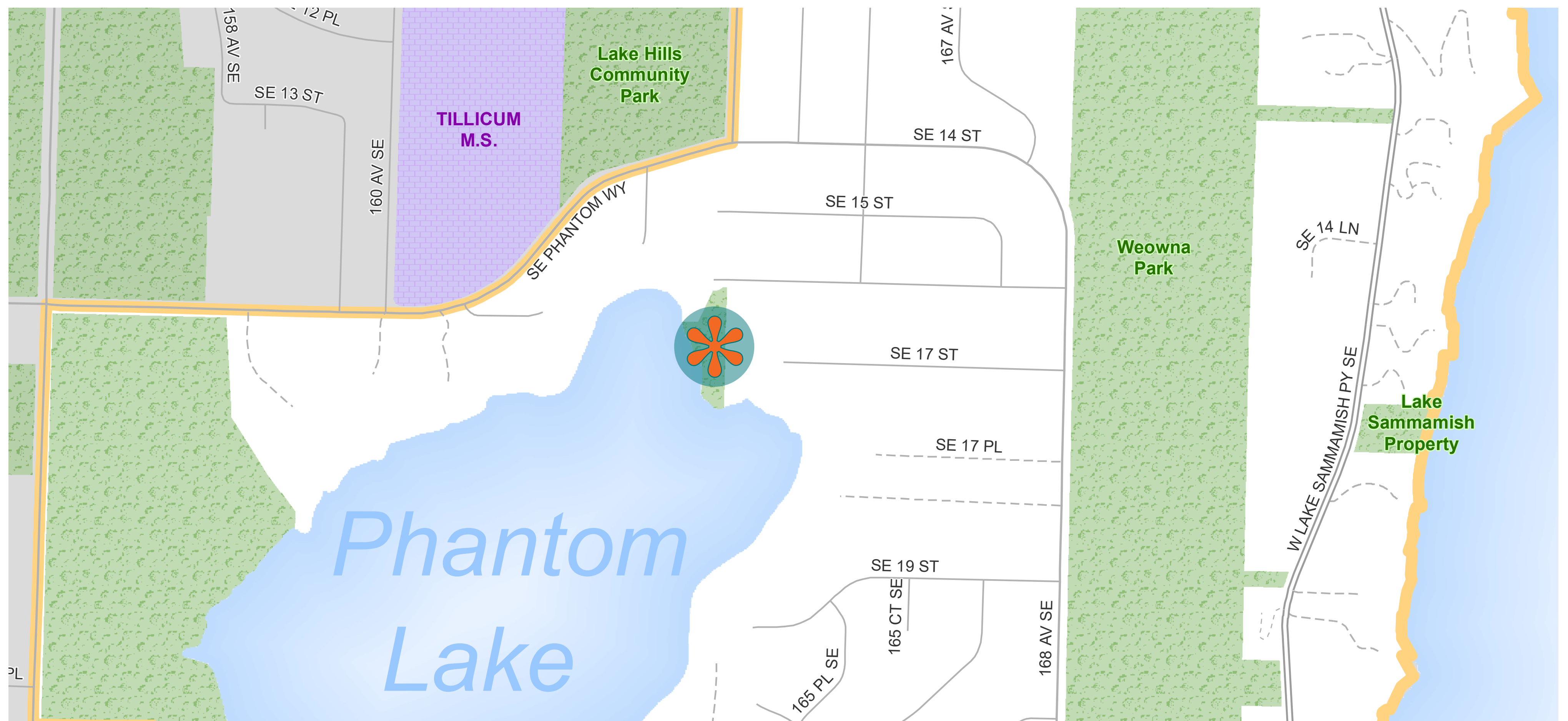
WLS-4 PARK AMENITIES

WEST LAKE SAMMAMISH



cost \$15,300

location Robinsglen Nature Park



description This project would provide two viewing benches and two picnic tables on a concrete pad in the grassy area with views of the lake. A new entry sign would also be provided.



WLS-5 SPIRITRIDGE PLAYGROUND

WEST LAKE SAMMAMISH



cost \$40,000

location Spiritridge Park



description This project would expand the playground footprint to the east, allowing for a larger toddler (two to five year-olds) play area. The existing swing set would be moved east to accommodate necessary clearances between the expanded toddler play area and the five to 12 year-old play equipment. Proposed play equipment for the toddler area would be posted at the site for community comment, during project development.



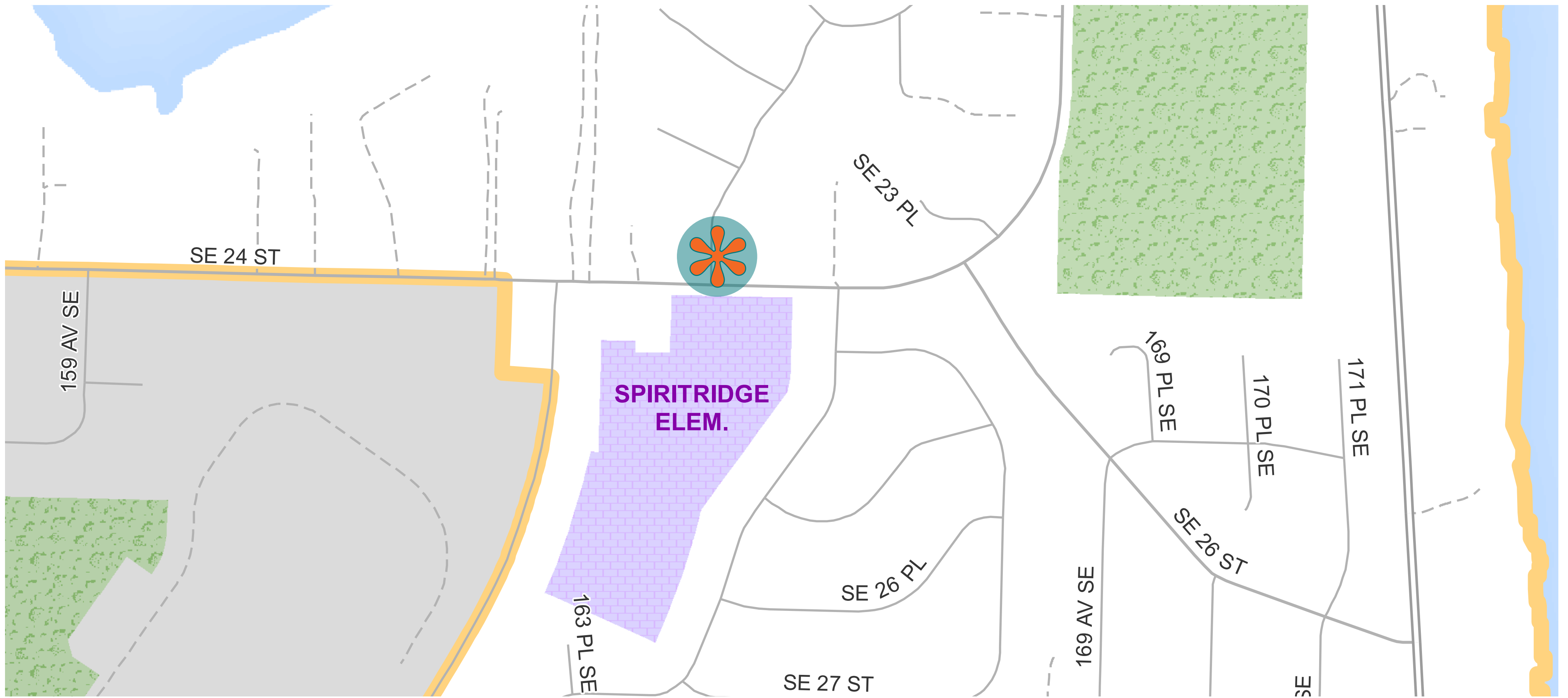
WLS-6 SE 24TH STREET RADAR SIGNS

WEST LAKE SAMMAMISH



cost \$40,000

location SE 24th Street, in the vicinity of Spiritridge Elementary School



description This project would install speed radar feedback signs at the two, existing flashing beacons on SE 24th Street, in the vicinity of Spiritridge Elementary.



WLS-7 SE 24TH STREET STREETLIGHTS

WEST LAKE SAMMAMISH



cost \$15,000

location SE 24th Street, from 158th Avenue SE to 161st Avenue SE



description This project would install up to four new streetlights and poles along SE 24th Street, between 158th and 161st Avenues SE.



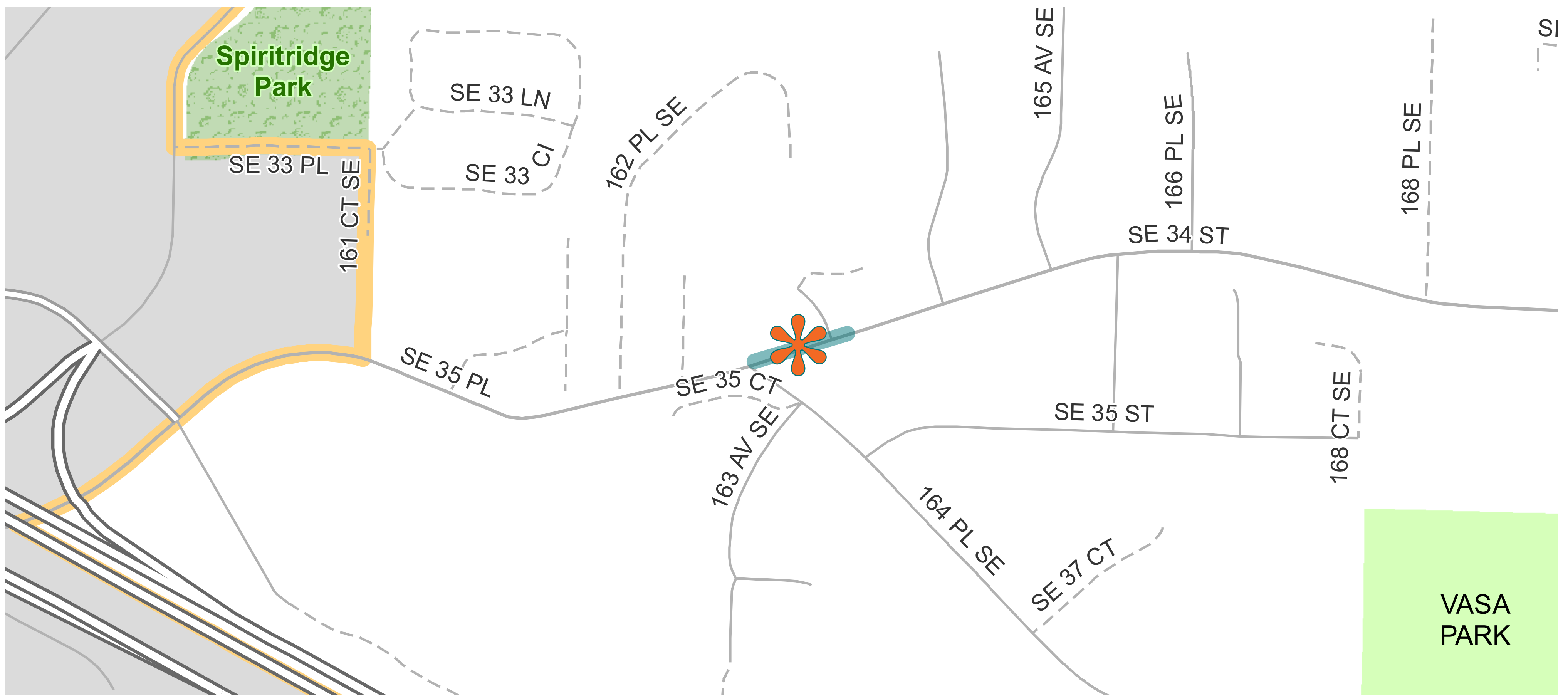
WLS-8 SE 34TH STREET ASPHALT SHOULDER

WEST LAKE SAMMAMISH



cost \$60,000

location SE 34th Street, east of 164th Place SE



description This project would install a widened, paved shoulder along the south side of SE 34th Street, beginning at 164th Place SE and ending approximately 250 feet east. This project would replace the existing path along the side of the road with a wider shoulder area for people walking.



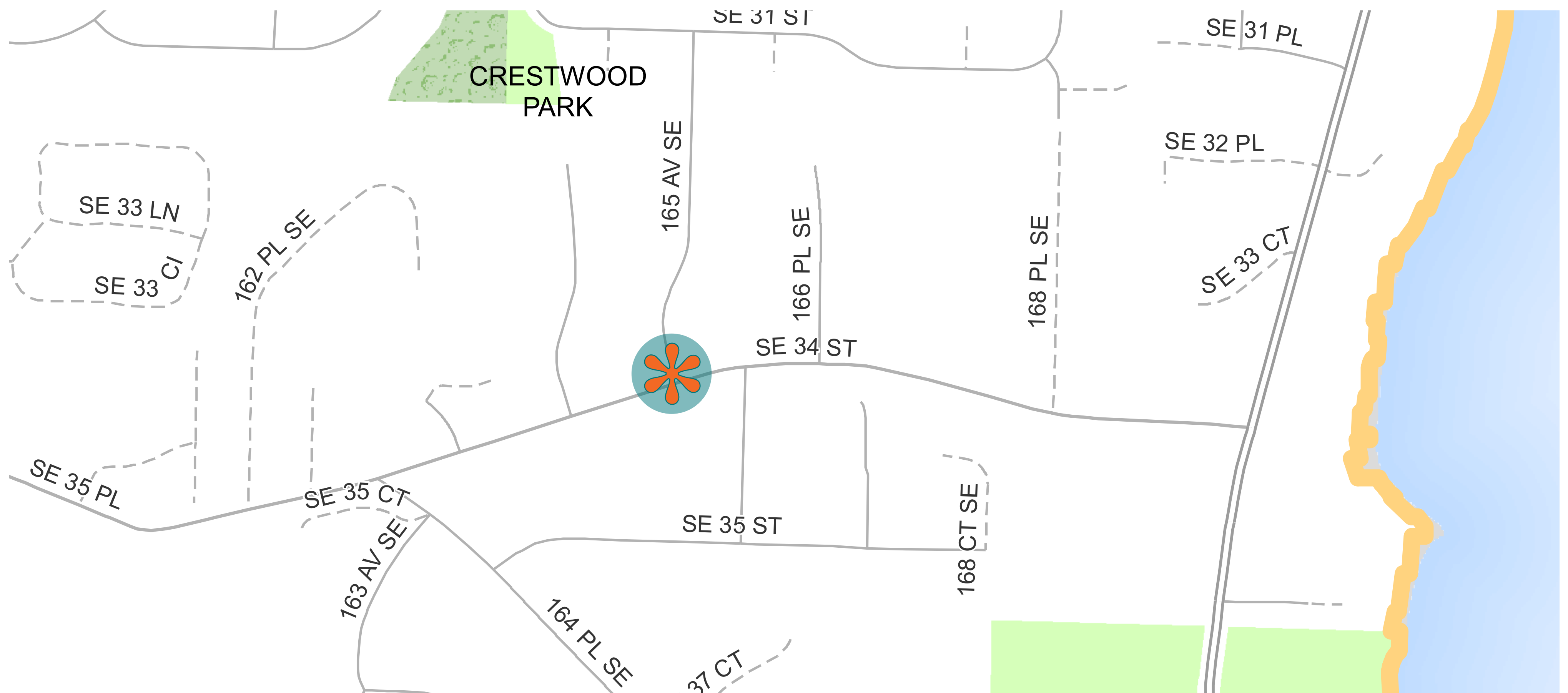
WLS-9 SE 34TH ST. & 165TH AVE. SE CORNER

WEST LAKE SAMMAMISH



cost \$20,000

location NE Corner of SE 34th Street & 165th Avenue SE



description This project would provide a paved path, bench and enhanced landscaping on the northeast corner of SE 34th Street and 165th Avenue SE, behind the existing streetlight and speed radar feedback sign.



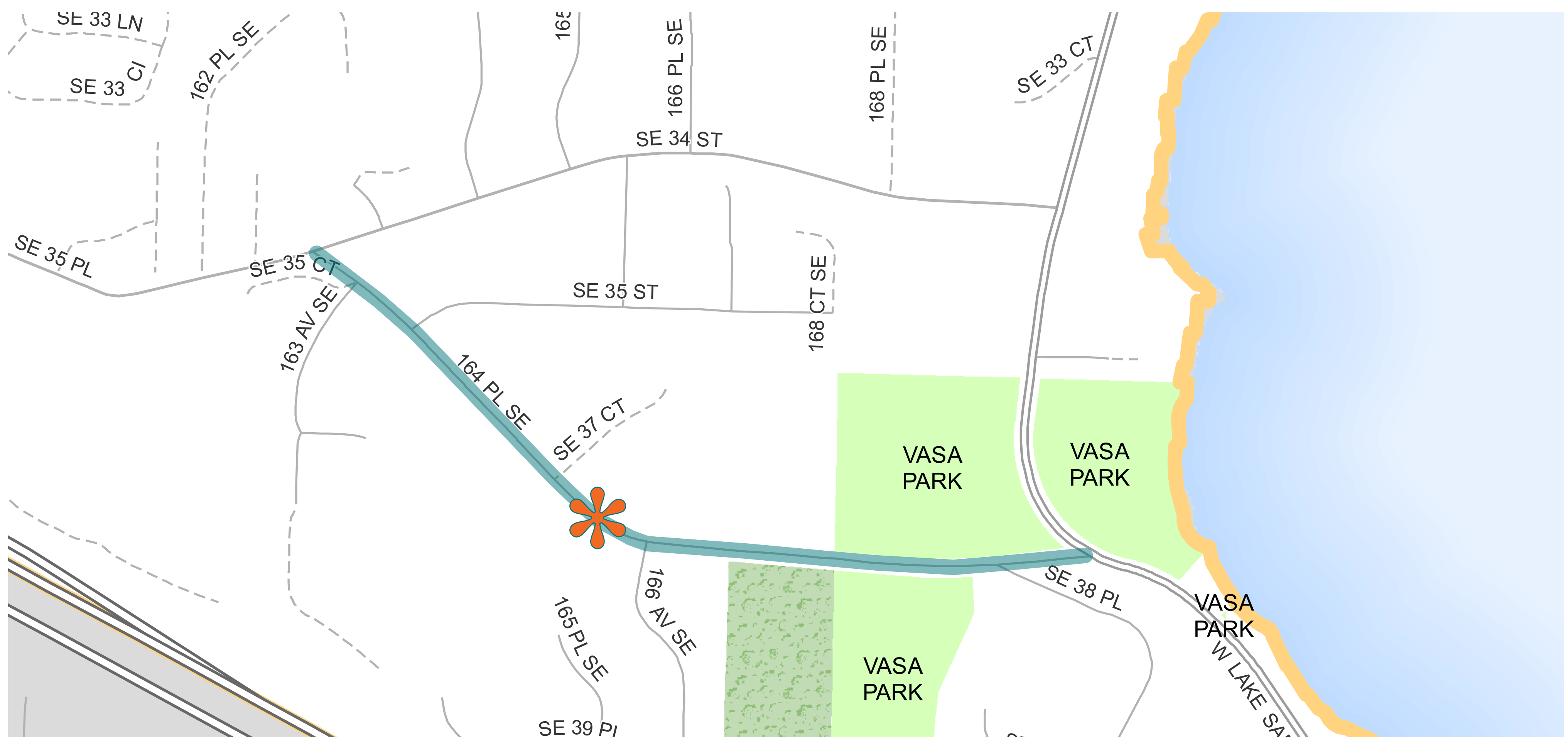
WLS-10 164TH PLACE SE TRAFFIC CALMING

WEST LAKE SAMMAMISH



cost \$75,000

location 164th Place SE/SE 38th Street; SE 34th Street to West Lake Sammamish Parkway



description This project would provide traffic calming elements, such as modified speed humps, on 164th Place SE/SE 38th Street, between SE 34th Street and West Lake Sammamish Parkway. If selected by NEP, this project would receive supplemental funding from the Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program, which would work with the community to identify preferred project elements.



WLS-11 166TH AVENUE SE TRAFFIC CALMING

WEST LAKE SAMMAMISH



cost \$75,000

location 166th Avenue SE, south of SE 24th Street



description This project would provide traffic calming elements on 166th Avenue SE, south of SE 24th Street, to improve traffic flow and pedestrian visibility. Possible elements could include a mountable traffic circle at SE 25th Street, or curb extensions at the SE 27th Street intersection. If selected by NEP, this project would receive supplemental funding from the Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program, which would work with the community to identify preferred project elements.



WLS-12 167TH AVENUE SE WALKWAY

WEST LAKE SAMMAMISH



cost \$20,000

location 167th Avenue SE, from SE 14th Street to Lake Hills Boulevard



description This project would install a painted walkway on the east side of 167th Avenue SE, from SE 14th Street to Lake Hills Boulevard. The proposed, five-foot-wide walkway would be delineated with a paint line, maintain an 11-foot-wide vehicular travel lane, and restrict parking on the east side of the street.

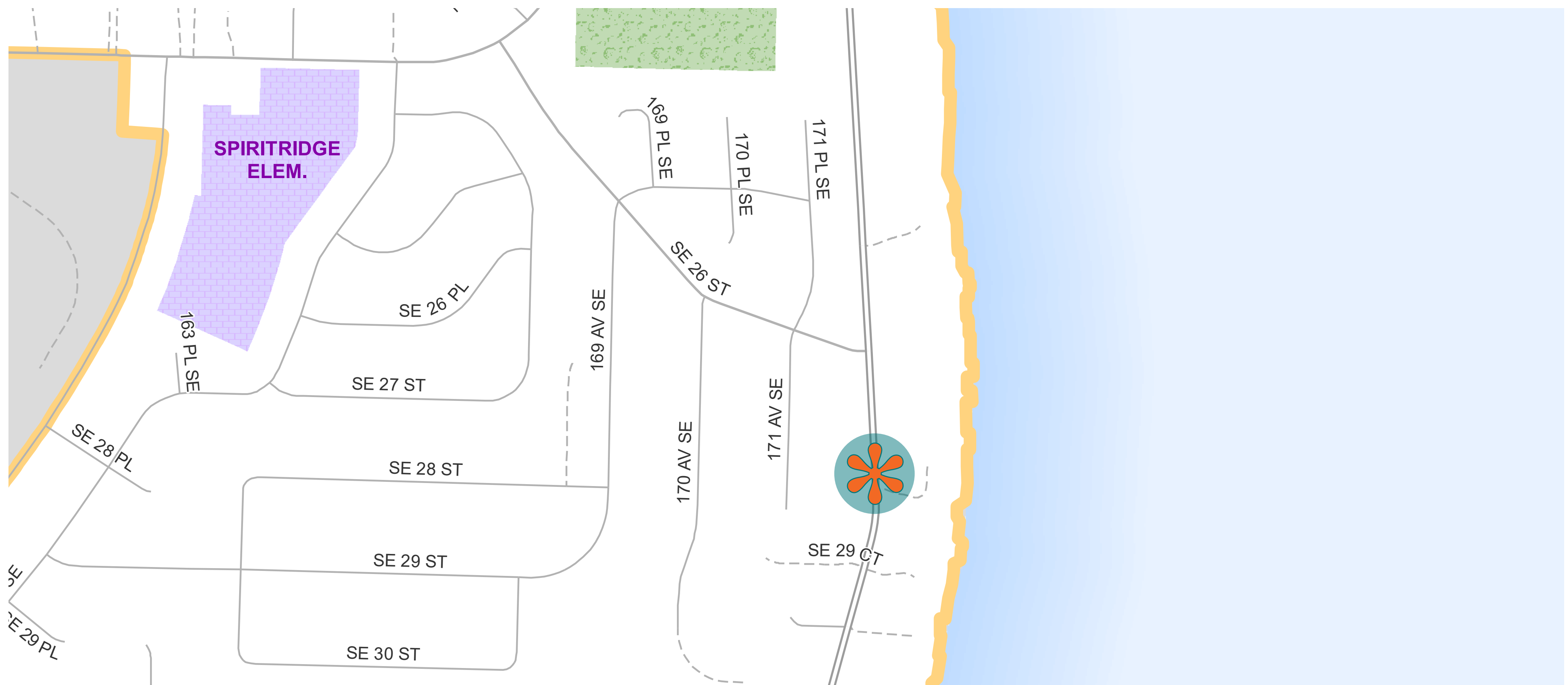
WLS-13 WLS PKWY FLASHING CROSSWALK

WEST LAKE SAMMAMISH



cost \$105,000

location West Lake Sammamish Parkway at The Little Store



description This project would install a rapid rectangular flashing beacon (RRFB) crosswalk and additional streetlights on West Lake Sammamish Parkway, south of SE 26th Street, near The Little Store. This project would also incorporate vegetation trimming to ensure adequate sight distance requirements.



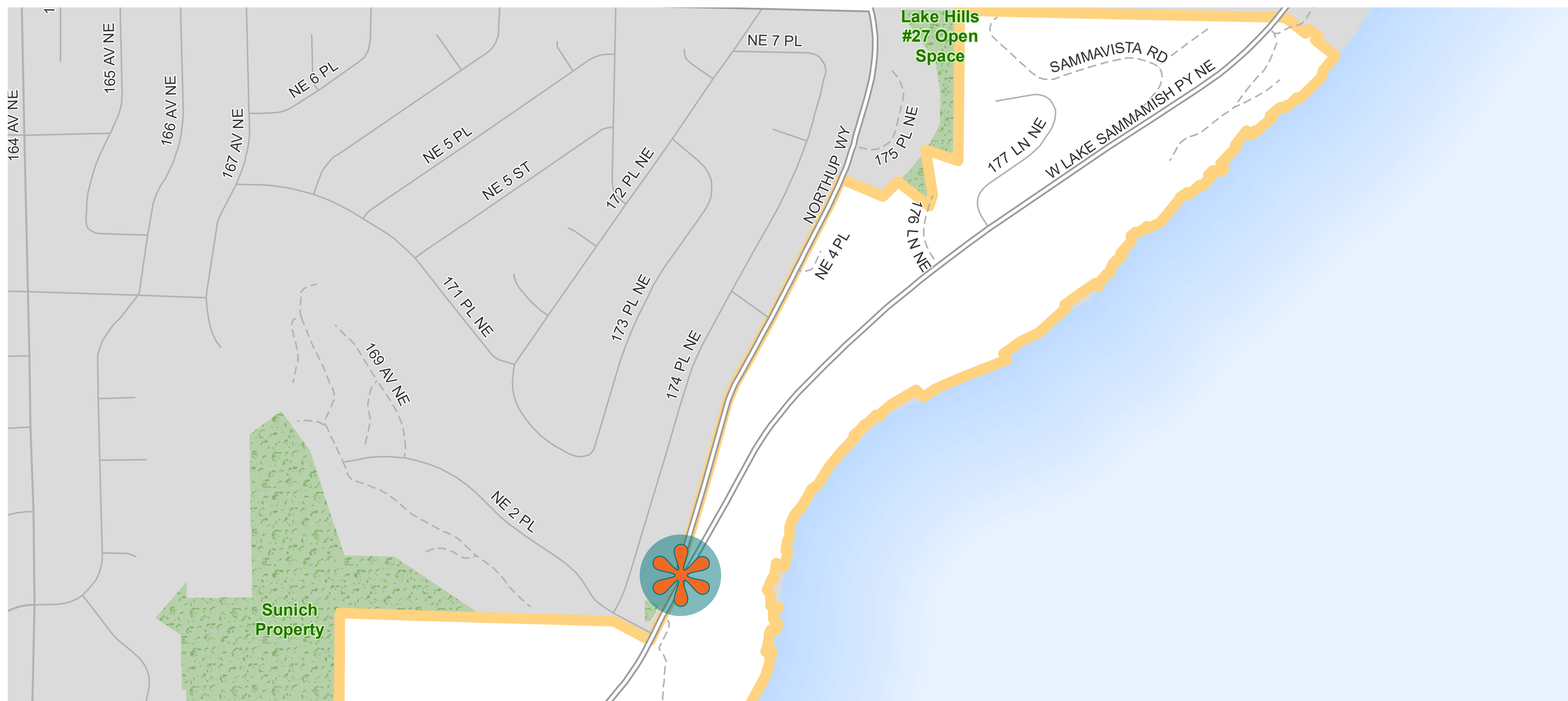
WLS-14 NORTHUP WAY LEFT TURN LANE

WEST LAKE SAMMAMISH



cost \$55,000

location Northup Way at West Lake Sammamish Parkway



description This project would extend the left turn lane on Northup Way, at West Lake Sammamish Parkway, by modifying the existing median and lane configuration. Construction of the project would begin after the watermain replacement on West Lake Sammamish, scheduled for late 2017, and would not require closing the intersection.



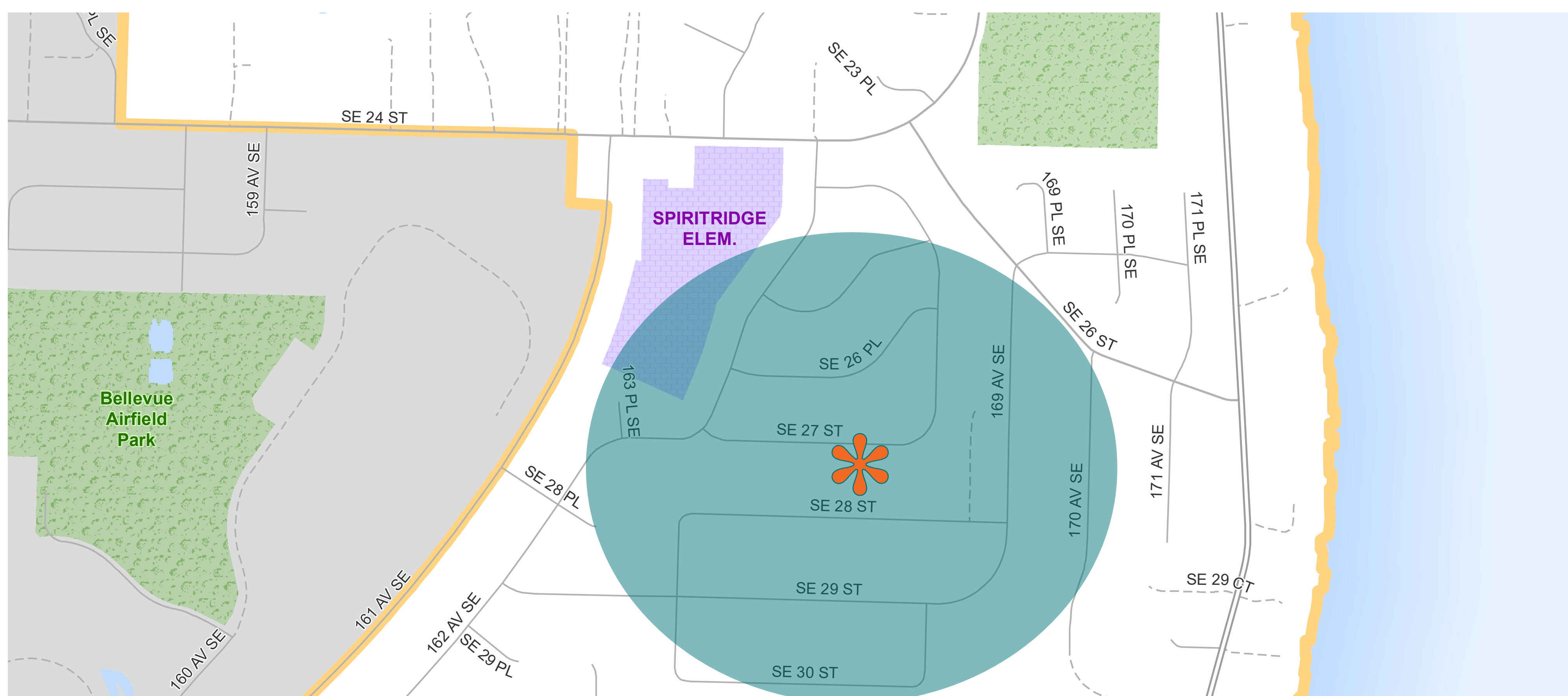
WLS-15 SPIRITRIDGE/LAKECREST LIGHTS

WEST LAKE SAMMAMISH

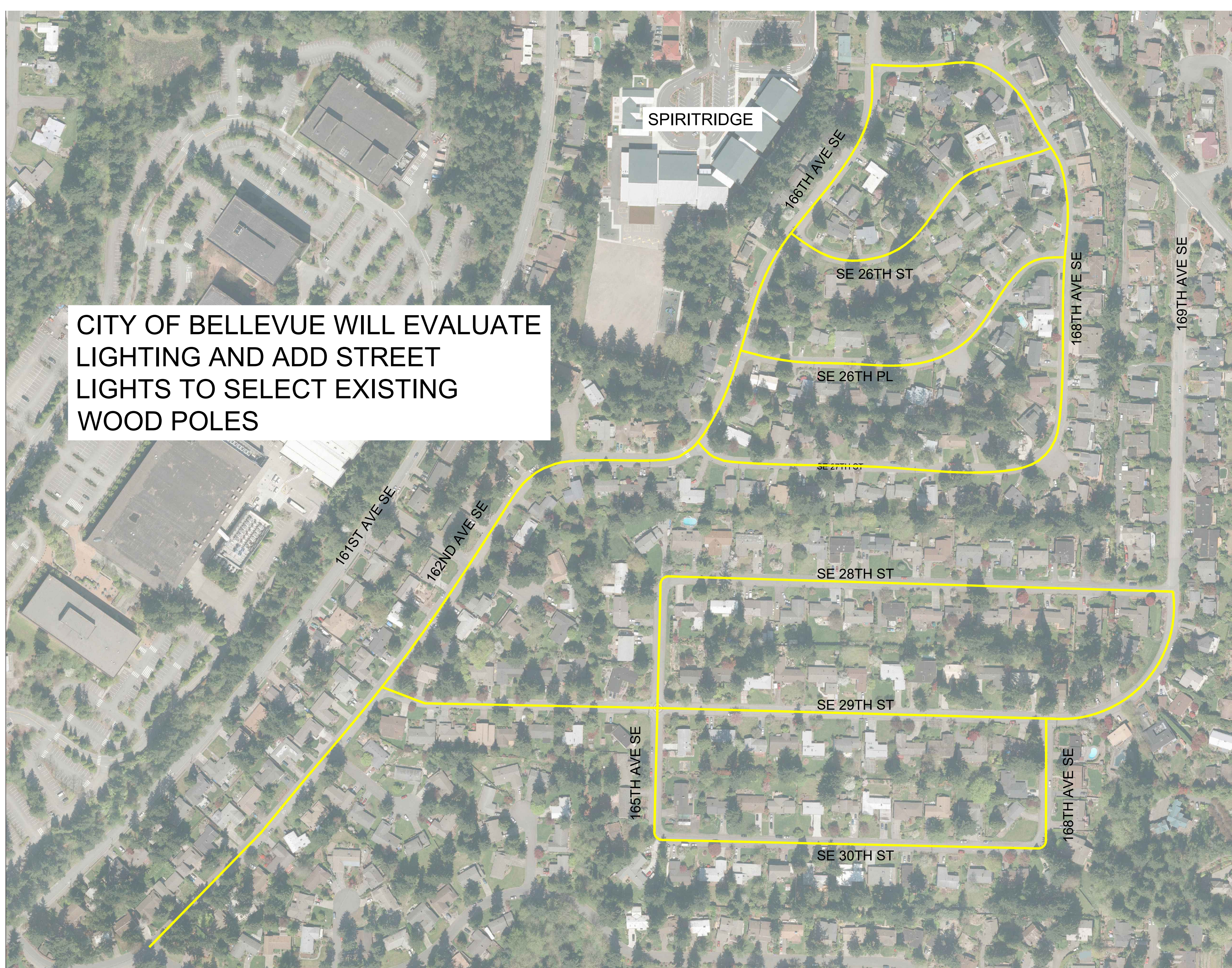


cost \$42,000

location Spiritridge and Lakecrest communities



description This project would install up to 30 new streetlights on existing poles in the Spiritridge and Lakecrest communities. The approval by adjacent resident homes would be required prior to light installation.



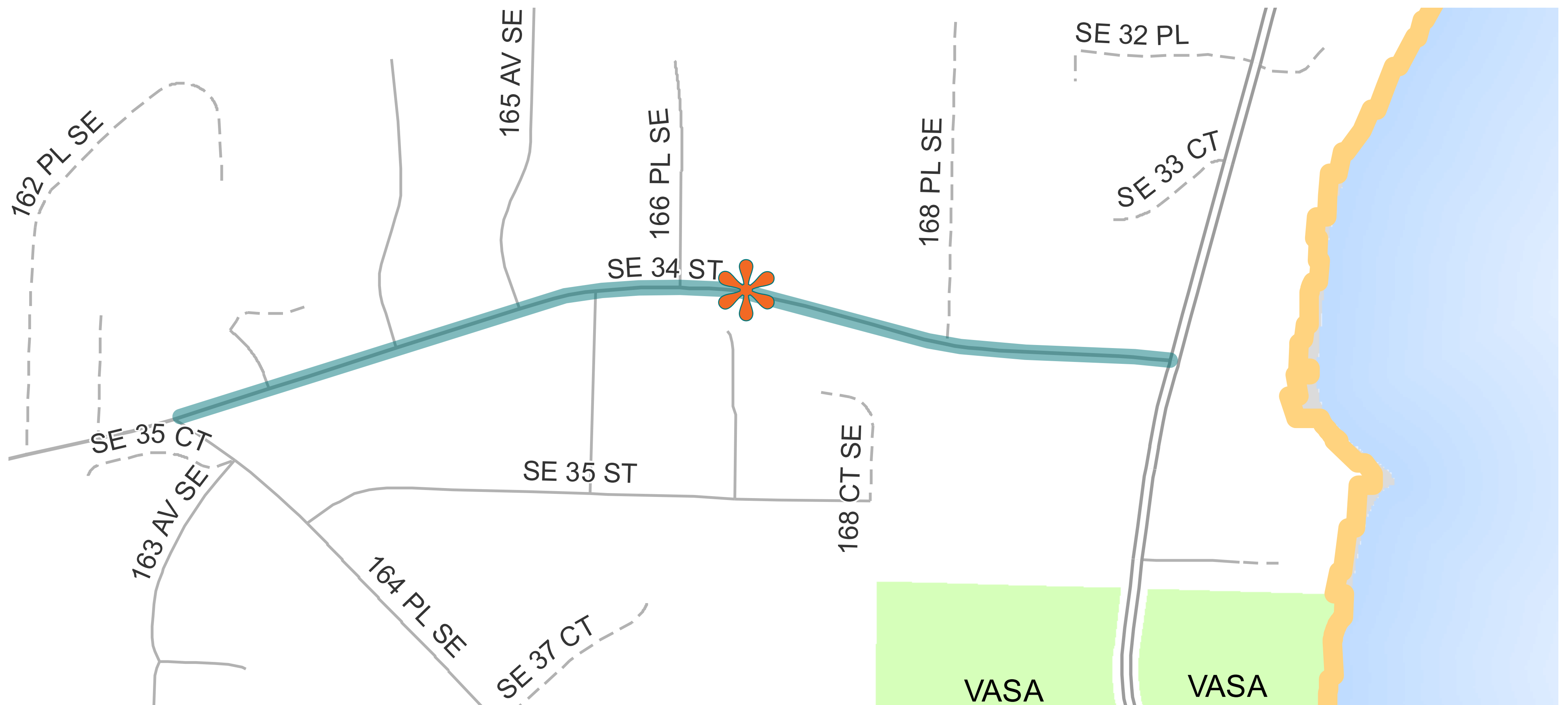
WLS-16 SE 34TH STREET STREETLIGHTS

WEST LAKE SAMMAMISH



cost \$20,000

location SE 34th Street; 164th Place SE to West Lake Sammamish Parkway



description This project would install up to eight, new streetlights and poles along SE 34th Street, between 164th Place SE and West Lake Sammamish Parkway.



WLS-17 WLS PARKWAY LANDSCAPING

WEST LAKE SAMMAMISH



cost \$38,000

location West Lake Sammamish Parkway; Sunrise Park to SE 40th Place; at SE 26th Street



description This project would enhance the landscaping on top of the recently completed retaining wall along the west side of West Lake Sammamish Parkway, between Sunrise Park and SE 40th Place. It would also include the clearing of weeds and addition of new landscaping at the northwest and southwest corners of the intersection of SE 26th Street and West Lake Sammamish Parkway.

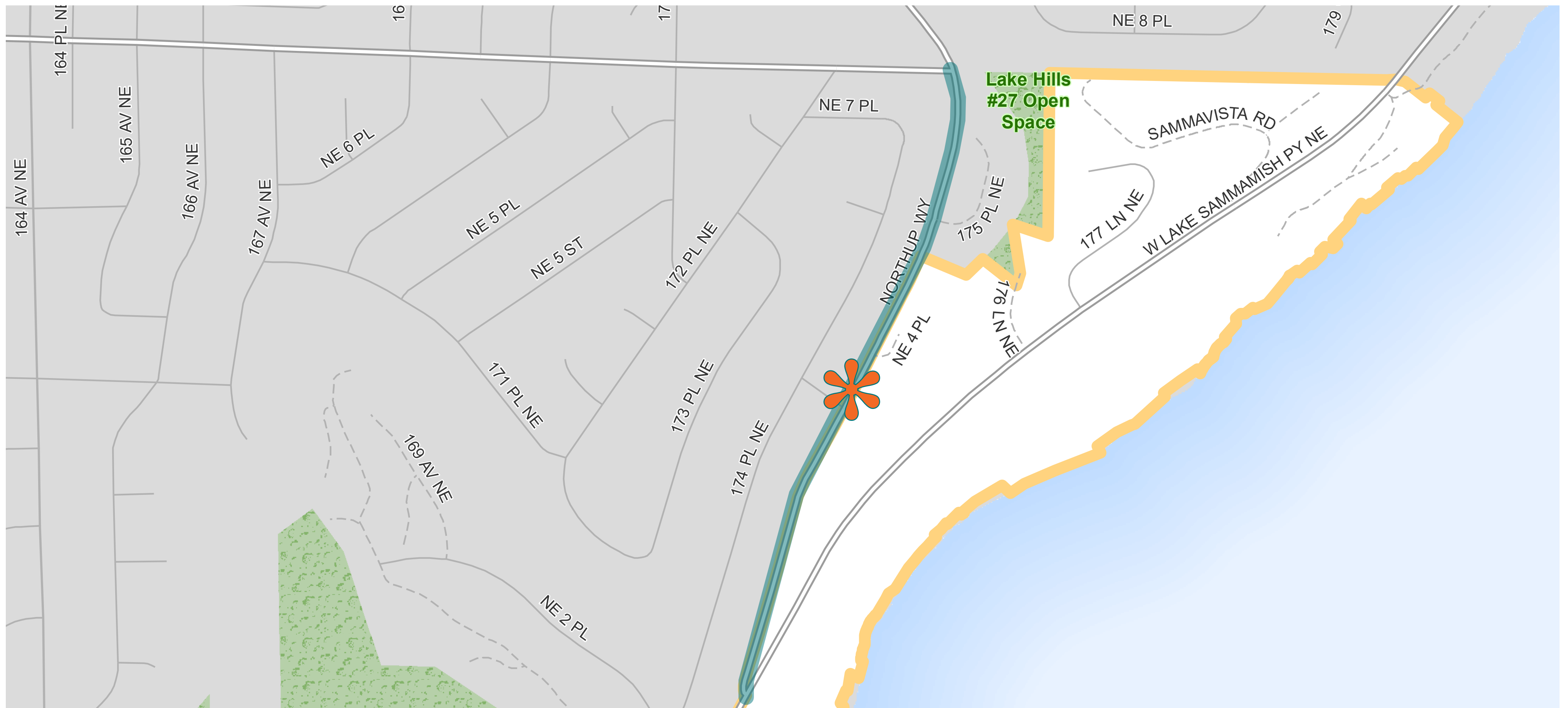
WLS-18 NORTHUP WAY LANDSCAPING

WEST LAKE SAMMAMISH



cost \$90,000

location Northup Way; NE 8th Street to West Lake Sammamish Parkway



description This project would identify specific areas for landscape enhancement along Northup Way, between NE 8th Street and West Lake Sammamish Parkway. Landscaping improvements would include new plants in attractive and easily maintained groupings, and the removal of invasive weeds, declining trees and undesired vegetation. Areas would be prioritized on availability of irrigation water and maintenance access.



WLS-19 161ST AVENUE SE MEDIAN

WEST LAKE SAMMAMISH



cost \$12,000

location 161st Avenue SE at Spiritridge Park



description This project would install irrigation in the median to help plantings that struggle to establish during summer drought periods. New, attractive landscaping would be designed and installed to complement the neighborhood and park.



WLS-20 168TH AVENUE SE BUS STOP

WEST LAKE SAMMAMISH



cost \$40,000

location 168th Avenue SE and SE 21st Place



description This project would provide a sidewalk around the southwest corner of 168th Avenue SE and SE 21st Place to the southbound bus stop. The bus stop would also be cleared of existing vegetation and provided with a concrete pad and bench. The concrete pad would be large enough to accommodate a potential, future bus shelter.
