Care is highly-coordinated and managed  
Interdisciplinary Team (IDT)

- Board Certified Geriatric Physician and NP
- Nurse Case Manager
- Therapists (Physical, Occupational, Recreational)
- Registered Dietician
- Social Workers
- Chaplain
- Personal Care Attendant (CNA)

# What are enrollment criteria?

- Age 55 +
- Certified by the State as eligible for nursing home level of care
- Lives in a zip code we serve
- Medicaid and Medicare eligible **OR** able to pay a Medicaid monthly premium



# What are enrollment criteria?

- Living in a safe and stable environment
- Willing to participate in a coordinated plan of care and receive all services from PACE and their contracted providers





# How will you Benefit?

- Close or extensive care coordination: wounds, DM+, anticoag, chronic pain
- Benefits from ADH, community
- Support for patient and family
- ElderPlace Transportation
- No co-pays, co-insurance
- Additional benefits not covered by Medicare/Medicaid - OTCs
